

GENERAL RULES

1. Division I and II entries must be pre-registered by July 31, 2025.
2. All entries will be received Sunday, August 3rd 7-8 pm or Monday August 4th 9-10am. All exhibits must be in place by 10:00 am on Monday August 4th. Doors will be locked for judging at 10:30. Doors open at 12:00 for the show.
3. Designs must be arranged by exhibitor. To educate the public all plant material should be correctly listed on a 3x5 index card and placed with exhibit.
4. All designs will be placed in front of a solid black background provided by Flower Show committee.
5. It is highly recommended to accessorize and have fun with category theme.
6. Plant material used in the designs need not have been grown by the exhibitor.
7. No artificial flowers or foliage permitted.
8. Youth category must be arranged by a youth age 12 & under.
9. All entries must be left in place until 7:30pm on Monday August 4th. All exhibits must be picked up and removed by 9 pm.
10. Each class will be judged and ribbons awarded, as well as a ribbon for Best of Show.

DIVISION I - FRESH FLOWER ARRANGEMENTS

A. "A Tribute to"

Use your artistic freedom to honor someone's memory. Incorporate personalized elements, choose flowers that reflect the individual's personality or hobbies. Please note who your design is representing.

B. "Everything But the Kitchen Sink"

A vignette of a fresh arrangement incorporating any items from the kitchen. Be creative!

C. "Jewels For a Garden Party"

Design using fresh and/or dried plant material in creating a necklace, ring, earrings or a complete set. Designs will be staged on a jewelry mannequin display supplied by the flower show committee.

D. "Short & Sweet"

Construct a miniature fresh floral arrangement not to exceed 5 inches in any direction.

E. "Breakfast in Bed"

A functional table set for one breakfast place setting, displayed on a tray including a fresh floral arrangement.

F. "A Modern Moment"

A freestyle arrangement using an artistic style of modern design.

DIVISION II - YOUTH

Flowers must be arranged by youth 12 & under

A. "Creative Container"

Design a fresh floral arrangement using a container that is recycled, repurposed or decorated with recycled materials.

B. "Mason Jar Posy"

Create a fresh floral design in a pint or quart size mason jar.

DIVISION III - HORTICULTURE

HORTICULTURE SPECIMENS

One cut flower or foliage stem in clear glass bottle. All exhibits in the specimen class must be grown by the exhibitor and displayed in a clear glass bottle furnished by the Flower Show committee.

POTTED PLANTS, DISH GARDENS, SUCCULENTS, PRESSED FLOWER DESIGNS & DRIED FLORAL DESIGNS

No limit to entries.
