Old Home Week Flower Show August 5 & 6, 2019

GENERAL RULES

- 1. Exhibitors are permitted to enter more than one division, but only one exhibit in its class.
- 2. Designs must have been arranged by exhibitor. For educational purposes, all plant material should be correctly listed on a 3×5 card and placed with exhibit.
- 3. Entries of Division I Horticulture, Division II- Miniatures, (No Pre-entry required for Divisions I and II). Division III Artistic Design, Division IV (Card Tables), Pre-entry is required and spaces are limited for Divisions III and IV). All exhibits will be received Monday, August 5, 7:00 to 10:00 am. All exhibits must be in place by 10:00 am.
- 4. The area in which your arrangements will be displayed measures 36" high, 30" wide and 18" deep. Arrangements **should not** be outside these dimensions.
- 5. Backboards will be furnished to you for painting or covering with material. They are the property of the Greencastle-Antrim Lioness Club. If material is used, it needs to be stretched tightly over the board, **not draped**.
- 6. Plant material in the Artistic Design Division need not be grown by the exhibitor, but the design must be the work of the one exhibiting.
- 7. Each class is limited to three entries.
- 8. Only flower show judges and chairman of the flower show committee plus one committee member will be permitted on the floor during judging.
- 9. All entries must be left in place until 3:00 pm on Tuesday, August 6, 2019 and may be removed no later than 4:00 pm or we will not be responsible for them.
- 10. All entries must be checked with the classification committee before putting them in place.
- 11. While the show committee will exercise due caution in safe-guarding the exhibits, it cannot assume the responsibility for injury or loss.
- 12. No artificial flowers, fruit, vegetables or foliage may be used in the arrangements.
- 13. Treatment or coloring of fresh plant material is not allowed.
- 14. Each class will be judged and ribbons awarded, including Best of Show.

DIVISION I - HORTICULTURE

CLASS I

POTTED PLANTS TO INCLUDE SUCCULANTS

All entries in the Horticulture division must have been grown by the exhibitor and should be labeled as to variety whenever possible.

The plant should be exhibited in clean unwrapped pot.

CLASS II HORTICULTURE SPECIMENS

One cut flower in clear glass bottle. All exhibits in the specimen class *must be grown by the exhibitor* and exhibited in a clear glass bottle furnished by the Lioness Club. No limit to entries.

DIVISION II - MINIATURES

CLASS I FRESH AND/OR DRIED

Not over 6" high overall.

Container should be in scale with flower arrangement.

No limit to entries.

CLASS II FAIRY GARDENS/DISH GARDENS

Miniature by nature, use your imagination and be creative.

DIVISION III - ARTISTIC DESIGN "The Bloomin' Holiday"

CLASS I - FRESH ARRANGEMENTS (amateurs only)

A. Mother's Day

Fresh flowers arranged paying tribute to Mothers. Using accessories of your choice.

B. Independence Day

Fresh arrangement using the "AMERICANA" colors and accessories.

C. Thanksgiving Day

Fresh arrangement using flowers and choice of fresh fruit and fresh vegetables in the colors of Autumn.

CLASS II

FRESH AND/OR DRIED ARRANGEMENTS (amateurs only)

A. Sandy Hollow

Use fresh and/or dried flowers arranged ready to take to a picnic.

B. High Line Railroad Station

Fresh and/or dried flowers will do well with this rail travel theme.

C. Jerome King Playground

Use fresh and/or dried flowers to create the feeling of being a kid again. And of course, any accessories to create the illusion as well.

DIVISION IV - DINNER ANYONE?

CLASS I

FRESH ARRRANGEMENT FOR DINNER TABLE. A CANDLE MUST BE USED IN THE ARRANGEMENT

35" Square card table furnished by Lioness Club. Tablecloth to be furnished by exhibitor. Place setting may consist of: plate, cup, saucer, soup bowl, stemware and napkins. No flatware please.
