

How to report 1st covering and/or reproduction events

Reporting 14 days after 1st covering at the latest.

Part A. Must always be completed.

Part B. 1st covering

If the mare is not registered at the National Centre, Horses please mark whether a copy of the original registration papers is enclosed or not.

If the mare has not previously been registered at the National Centre, Horses, the fields “Is the mare pedigree known” and “app. year of birth of mare” are to be filled in.

Please note that 1st covering should not be filled in if the mare returns to oestrus and is covered/inseminated again by the same stallion. Return to oestrus is reported under Reproduction events.

You must only fill in one date, month and year in the “date of 1st covering “ field.

In the “covering method” field, you must mark the method by which the mare has been covered/inseminated and/or whether an egg has been transplanted.

If the mare/dam has been covered by a stud stallion, please note that the date of 1st covering is the date where stallion and mare are put together, whether the covering act has been seen or not.

Part C. Reproduction events.

All fields in a row must be filled in/marked.

It is possible to report reproduction events for different dams/mares in the same forms. One of the reproduction events fields must always be marked, and the addition code must always be put against the reproduction you wish to report.

Description of reproduction events:

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Can only be reported if a previous report of 1st covering by the same stallion has been made.

One of the following **additional codes** must be stated.

- 1: Mare to stallion station
- 2: Transport of stallion
- 4: Insemination, fresh semen
- 5: Insemination, transported semen
- 6: Insemination, frozen semen
- 3: Beginning of stud stallion covering period
- 12: End of stud stallion covering period

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Is reported if it is confirmed that the mare is pregnant.

One of the following **additional codes** must be stated.

- 7: Hand examination
- 8: Scanning
- 9: Blood samples
- 10: Other pregnancy examination

Is reported if it is confirmed that the mare is not pregnant.

One of the following **additional codes** must be stated.

- 7: Hand examination
- 8: Scanning
- 9: Blood samples
- 10: Other pregnancy examination

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Is reported if it is confirmed that the mare has aborted the foal/embryo.

One of the following **additional codes** must be stated.

- 1: Early abortion
- 2: Foetus found
