

A strategy to improve language development during everyday routines.

## **Expansion & Extension**

**Expansion**: taking what a child says and adding missing words and/or correcting grammatical errors, using their same words and implied meaning.

## Example:

- Child says: Car fast.
- SLP/Caregiver expands: The car is driving fast.

**Extension**: taking what a child says and adding more or new information when responding back. Example:

- Child says: Baby eat.
- SLP/Caregiver extends: Yes, the baby is hungry.

## When to use:

- Natural settings
- Daily routines
  - o On a walk
  - Preparing a meal
  - Story time
  - Floor play
  - Getting dressed

Benefits: grammar, vocabulary, syntax, comprehension, context clues, and child may imitate/repeat back what they hear.
