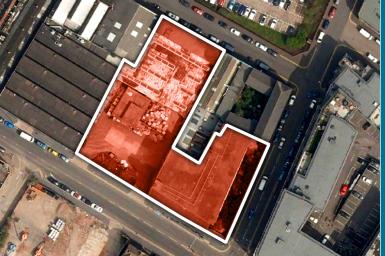

LOCATION

The property is situated in the Digbeth district of Central Birmingham, around 0.5 miles south of the Bullring and other city centre amenities. More specifically the property is situated at the intersection of Bradford Street with Alcester Street and can also be accessed via Green Street.

Digbeth has a traditional industrial heritage which is undergoing considerable residential redevelopment. Surrounding uses include St Annes Church, residential apartment schemes and various commercial properties to include car repair specialists, manufacturing premises and public houses.

The site is within a short distance of several Ofsted rated schools, both primary and secondary. The property is situated in the heart of the local transport network. By road, the property is situated only 4 miles from Junction 6 of the M6 motorway, 8 miles from Junction 3 of the M5 motorway and 9 miles from Junction 6 of the M42 motorway, via excellent local road connections from the A4540 ring road, A38 and A456. In 2015, Birmingham New Street Station completed a £650 million refurbishment and offers a recognised interchange station with peak time journey times to London of 1 hr 23 minutes.

Situated only 0.8 miles from the property, the station is the busiest in the UK, outside of London with more than 140,000 people passing through daily. The property is also 0.6 miles from Moor Street Station and 1.1 miles from Snow Hill Station, both offering local stopping services. In February 2017, HS2 was granted Royal Assent allowing phase 1 construction to begin. Journey times from the proposed Curzon Street station (1.1 miles from the property) are proposed to be reduced to 49 minutes. The property will benefit from the additional phase of the Midland Metro Tram extension which is proposed to stop at Deritend High Street.

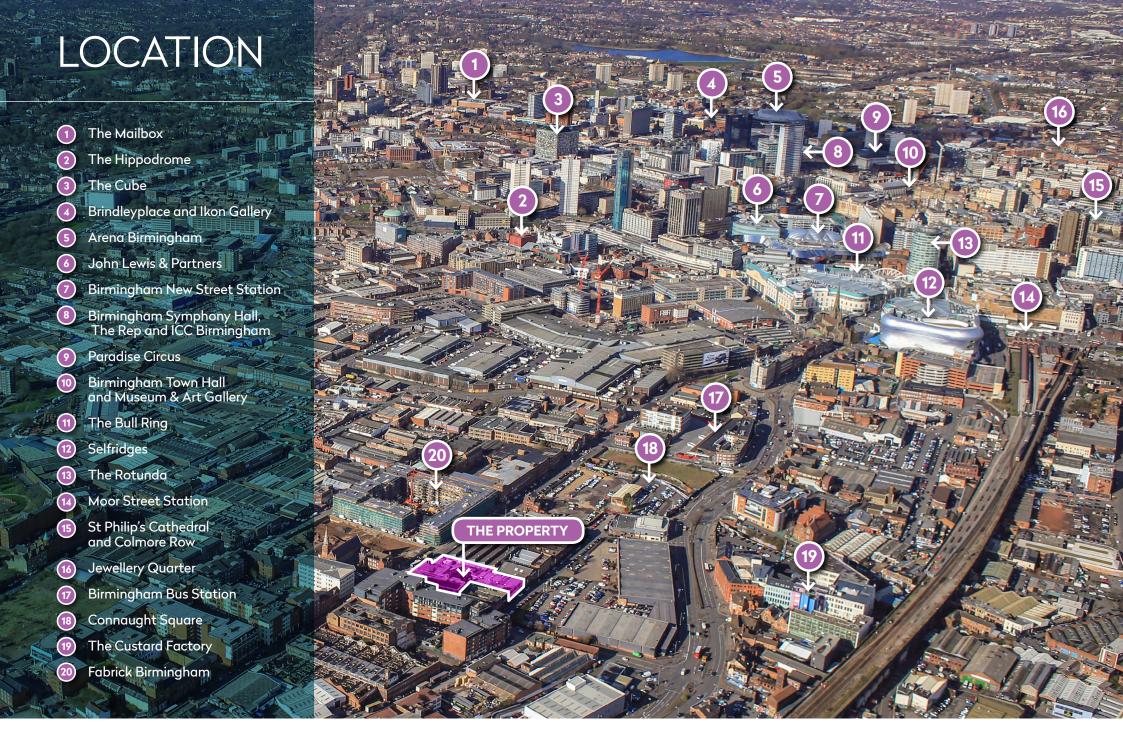

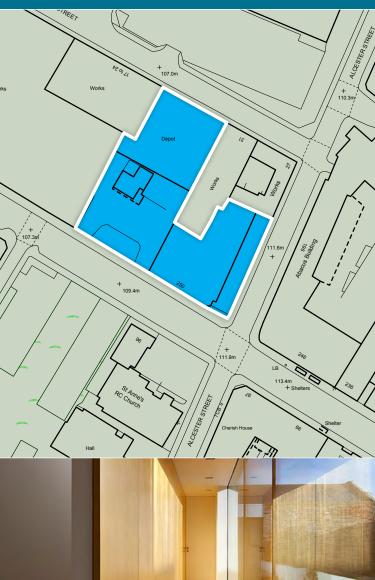

The boundary of the site is delineated in white on the adjacent site plan and is measured to be approximately 0.82 acres (0.33 ha) gross.

The site currently comprises derelict buildings together with an open surfaced yard with frontages to Bradford Street, Alcester Street and Green Street. A three storey existing building is situated at the intersection of Bradford Street with Alcester Street with a secure yard adjacent and a further two storey building is accessed via Green Street.

The site slopes from a high point in the south east corner at the junction of Alcester Street and Bradford Street and levels fall across the site to the north west.

The south western boundary borders Bradford Street and the south eastern boundary borders Alcester Street. The north eastern boundary adjoins an adjacent converted apartment scheme, a commercial premises and also partly borders Green Street. The north western and south western elevations also adjoin commercial premises.

The current vehicular access is available from Bradford Street into the existing yard and also via loading door access on Alcester Street and Green Street but we understand the proposed scheme to incorporate a vehicular access from Green Street.

Tenure

The property is to be sold freehold in its current condition.

The property is sold subject to all third party rights, easements and statutory designations currently passing.

Planning

The property benefits from planning permission for the demolition of the existing buildings and erection of 130 residential units varying from 4 to 8 storeys with 40 parking spaces and associated works in accordance with planning application Ref 2016/08443/PA.

The planning permission is subject to a Section 106 agreement which makes the following index linked provisions:

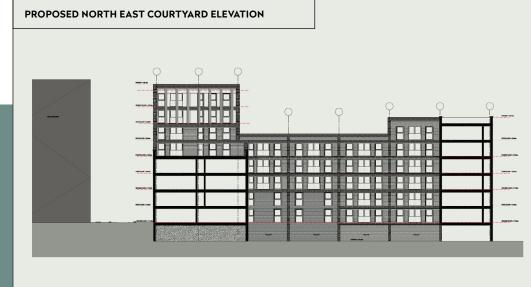

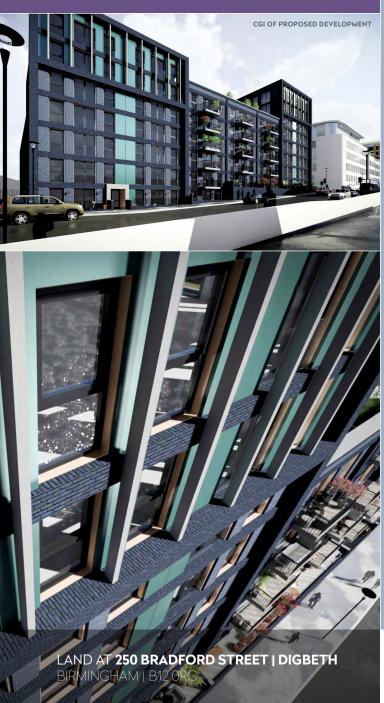

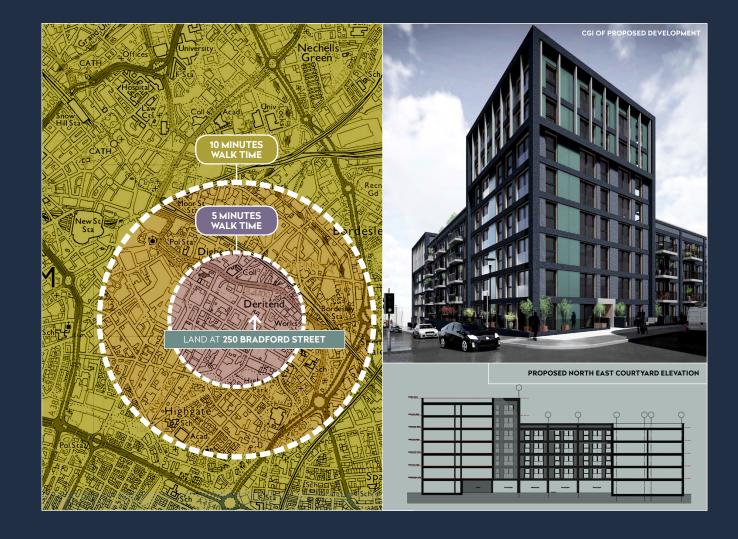
