Leadership Ministry – Prayer June 10, 2018 v2

Psalm 127:1 Unless the Lord builds the house, the builders labor in vain...

Raise up Leaders for God's people – Apostles, Prophets, Pastors, Teachers, Evangelists

Apostles: (sanctification to move in authority)

- Apostles have great discernment in faith and authority to impart gifts for ministry
- Discernment of appropriate spiritual strengths to impart to help people grow
- Apostles develop well their main gifts of ministry as well as secondary gifts
- Apostles have good vision of discipleship and can easily teach concepts
- Apostles impart & raise up intercessory ministries for corporate body
- Apostles have discernment of ministries to those the Lord is calling

Prophets: (sanctification to move in authority)

- Prophets are set apart unto the Lord as his messengers to serve the body
- Prophets will discharge the revelation given accurately and in right timing
- They will act and speak under God's leading and not under their own strong feelings

Evangelists: (sanctification to move in authority)

- Evangelists be motivators to inspire body to greater faith and commitment of service.
- Evangelists have discernment of spiritual needs and wisdom to speak to them.
- Evangelists give Word the Lord has given and not their own perceptions

Pastors: (sanctification to move in authority)

- Pastors have greater heart of nurture, compassion with discernment of needs.
- Pastors have greater wisdom to deal with needs of people and help them overcome
- Pastors have inspirational messages from Lord to encourage growth

Teachers: (sanctification to move in authority)

- Teachers have greater insight to take people deeper in faith and knowledge of the Lord
- Teachers have wisdom to give knowledge in insightful manner and understood by body
- Teachers discern spiritual needs of Body and have wisdom to meet needs

Leadership Qualities: (sanctification in character and abilities)

- Understanding "Ministry of the Word" is insight from Lord not ideals of man.
- Spirit fulfil mandate to bring the Body to maturity through his Leaders (Eph 4)
- Unity and sanctification to act in faith as ministry team
- Heart of integrity with humility toward people and God
- Discernment of intents and motives of heart and wisdom to handle them.
- Discernment of God's will and ways and understanding to move in authority.
- Understanding of spiritual gifts and vision for discipleship in Body of Christ
- Increased childlike heart of gentleness, meekness, trust and submissiveness
- Greater experience of love, grace, mercy, compassion with increased joy of the Lord
- Deep conviction of faith in Lord's will and courage and decisiveness to act.
- Finances and resources to run ministry and meet personal needs.
