

Healing – Prayer May 26, 2018 v2

Psalm 127:1 Unless the Lord builds the house, the builders labor in vain...

- Raise up gifted ministry teams for healing with discernment and authority.
- Raise up those with gifts of revelation, discernment and wisdom.
- Stir up various gifts of healing, awareness and give a desire to serve on a team.
- Discernment of ailment root cause.
- Discernment and understanding to bring changes of heart for healing.
- Give stronger bond of love, unity of spirit and sanctify to work as ministry team.
- Stir up prayer ministries for healing. Awaken awareness of need in them.
- Stir people's openness to healing and desire to trust God for healing need.

Qualities for ministry mantle – sanctify to move in faith

- Integrity of heart and humility toward people and God.
- Discernment of intents and motives of heart
- Wisdom and knowledge to handle people.
- Child-like qualities of heart – meekness, gentleness and submissiveness.
- Deep conviction and knowing of faith in Lord's will.
- Boldness courage and decisiveness to act in faith.
- Give deeper experience of love, grace, mercy and compassion.

Healing needs (restore to original design and function)

- Congenital defects in development – physical and mental,
- Impaired vision, restoration of eyesight
- Dental reconstruction and restoration.
- Fatal diseases including viruses, cancer, fungal and bacterial infections.
- Body pain – inflammation, migraines, arthritis including fibromyalgia.
- Back and spinal problems.
- Blood diseases and deficiency.
- Respiratory congestion – lungs, sinus, airways.
- Heart and blood circulation problems including regeneration of capillaries.
- Muscle, joint and ligament damage, injured body parts
- Digestive tract, metabolism, weight problems, food allergies and nutrition.
- Nervous system, hormone, chemical, enzyme disorders including chemical allergies.
- Enhance digestive and immune system – cleanse of toxins, excess sugars, fats, etc.
- Restore beauty – skin and physical features. To those who lack it
