We have 2 sets of Hurst E-Tools and equipment on 2 separate fire trucks. We can go down both sides of a car to extricate multiple patients simultaneously or perform extrication on 2 separate vehicles. We can respond to 2 extrication calls at once in separate locations.

We have a complement of specialty tools to perform extraction other than Hurst E-Tools. Saws, stabilization jacks, cribbing, windshield cutters, and hand tools total roughly \$8,000.00 per set. We have 2 sets.
