All Tests of Choice rides must be specified on the entry form.

Freestyle riders must provide your own sound system.

- * Training Level and Western Dressage Tests may be ridden in a small or large arena subject to scheduling demands.
- Times will be posted on the HDA website (Heritage-Dressage.org) the Wednesday prior to show date; please no phone calls
- Classes will be divided into Junior/Adult Amateur/Open if entries warrant
- An individual horse may be entered in a maximum of 4 Introductory Level classes or 4 Introductory
 and Training Level classes combined. An individual horse may be entered in no more than 3
 classes at Training Level and above. This applies to the comparable Western Dressage Tests as
 well.
- Management reserves right to combine, cancel or divide classes if entries warrant
- No telephone or email entries will be accepted
- No entries will be accepted without payment
- . No refunds after the closing date
- If officials are forced to cancel a show after the closing date and if rescheduling is not possible, HDA will make every effort to make refunds if the show budget permits
- A \$25 fee will be charged for returned checks
- Protective headgear must be worn at all times while mounted

Year-End Award Rules 2020

- The rider must be an HDA member at the time of the show.
- Class Year-End Awards will be divided by Junior, Adult Amateur, and OPEN as entries warrant. (New Rule 2019)
- The horse and rider must be the same.
- The rider must ride the same test in a minimum of two HDA shows in that year.
- Once a horse and rider combination has competed in a Training Level class, they are no longer eligible to enter any USDF Introductory Level Tests.
- Awards shall be given for the highest average score in each test provided a minimum year-end average score of 55% is achieved
- If more than two of the same tests are ridden, the two highest scores will be used to calculate the final average.
- The rider must complete four hours of volunteer work (see HDA website for details).
