ORDINANCE NO. 2005-2

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A CURFEW AND ENUMERATING EXCEPTIONS THERETO FOR ANY MINOR UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS IN THE TOWNSHIP AND PROVIDING FOR ACCOUNTABILITY OF THE PARENTS OF MINORS FOR ANY VIOLATION OF SAID CURFEW, AND IMPOSING FINES AND PENALTIES IN CONNECTION WITH THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Point Township Board of Supervisors hereby ordains:

- A) It shall be unlawful for any minor under the age of 18 years to be in or upon the public streets, walkways, roads, alleys, parks or playgrounds, public buildings, vacant lots or other unsupervised places within the Township of Point between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. of the following day; provided, however, that the provisions of this subsection do not apply to a minor accompanied by his or her parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor, or to a minor who is upon an emergency errand or legitimate business directed by his or her parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor.
- B) It shall be unlawful for the parent, guardian or other adult person having care and custody of a minor under the age of 18 years to not only permit such minor to be in or upon the public streets, walkways, roads, alleys, parks or playgrounds, public buildings, vacant lots or other unsupervised places within the Township of Point between 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. of the following day; provided, however, that the provisions of this subsection do not apply when the minor is accompanied by his or her parent, guardian, or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor, or when the minor is upon an emergency errand or legitimate business.

directed by his or her parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor.

C) Any person violating the provisions of Section A and B of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$25.00, nor more than \$300.00, and costs of prosecution, and in default of the payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment for not less than 10 days, nor more than 90 days.
