PUBLIC NOTICE

The Point Township Police Department maintains Criminal History Record Information, (CHRI) on all individuals who have been arrested for a crime and subsequently fingerprinted as a result of such arrest.

- CHRI is maintained to provide criminal justice agencies and other interested persons with a chronological listing of past criminal behavior of persons fingerprinted as a result of an arrest.
- CHRI is used by criminal justice agencies as an investigative aid in criminal investigations.
- CHRI may be used by employers in determining the suitability of applicants.
- CHRI may be used by boards, commissions or departments of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania authorized to license, certify, register or permit the practice of trades, occupations or professions.
- CHRI may also be reviewed by the subject of such information to determine completeness and accuracy.

To obtain a copy of your CHRI maintained by The Point Township Police Department you must:

1. Complete the request for CHRI – Please see an officer.
2. Attach a check or money order in the amount of \$9.00 (US) payable to the “Point Township Police Department”. (criminal justice agency requests are exempt from fee)
3. Provide appropriate identification, (e.g., valid driver’s license or state issued photo ID)

Please be advised that the CHRI you receive from the Point Township Police Department is only that which is contained within the files of this agency. A summary of statewide CHRI may be obtained from:
