Geise just all bad news this last year. Can't get a hold of him, he doesn't answer you. I've been getting a lot of grief. It seems like he is all about football, and that's it, and that's not making a lot of other people happy.

MOTION made by Yoxheimer to give a 3% pay increase for the Secretary/Treasurer and a 3% plus a \$1.00 for becoming a Notary for the Office Clerk. Seconded by Neitz and passed with a vote of four (4), One (1) absent - Stender.

MOTION made by Yoxheimer to give a \$1.46 pay increase for the Roadmaster. Seconded by Neitz and passed with a vote of three (3); one (1) nay-Geise; and One (1) absent - Stender.

Geise don't we usually have discussion before you take the vote? It doesn't matter now; you already took the vote. How can you justify giving him an almost 8% raise? When you have our residents, who have lost their jobs, lost their livelihoods. And you're giving him an almost 8% raise when he isn't even doing the basic duties of a Roadmaster, they aren't getting done. I don't know how you justify that.

Peters and you're basing that on bad job performance?

Geise I am basing that on what I hear, what I see, and obviously his lack of credentials for being in that position to begin with.

Peters asked Amanda how many complaints we have gotten on Wehry.

McClain we haven't gotten any complaints, except the typical, you've plowed my driveway shut and that sort of thing. We haven't received anything, more praise than nays.

Yoxheimer asked Neitz what he was making when he left as Roadmaster.

Neitz I don't remember, but I know Geise got a lot more after I retired.

Yoxheimer asked Geise what his rate was when he left.

Geise I can't remember, right around \$24, I think.

Neitz I don't see a problem with giving Wehry \$20. I see him out working on the roads. He is out there working; he is doing a good job.

Geise I am more then willing to take anyone of you out on the roads and show you what I see.

Eisenhower I think we have had superb snow plowing. They were right there on the spot and came through several times.

Yoxheimer asked Wehry what his tenure with the township was.

Wehry I started the end of 2013 full time.

Yoxheimer George your concerns are noted, but like you said the vote has been taken.

Geise yep, I didn't expect anything less.

MOTION made by Yoxheimer to give a \$1.00 increase for Full-time Laborer – 1; and Full-time Laborer – 2 to stay at \$16.00. Seconded by Peters and passed with a vote of three (3); one (1) nay-Geise; and One (1) absent - Stender.

Wehry the plow lights we have now, are housed in plastic. As soon as you hit any kind of bump, or bounce the plow at all, they tend to break, or the bulbs will blow. Fisher makes an upgrade kit for these plows. They are LED in a metal housing, to help with the wear and tear. The lights shine out to the side and not just straight ahead. To have two plows done it would be around \$1,900.

Geise asked if the LED lights were heated?

Wehry not sure if they are.

Geise they need to be heated, because if not they will ice over, and you won't be able to see.

MOTION made by Yoxheimer to allow the purchase of new lighting units for the plows, conditioned upon the lenses being heated, not to exceed \$1,900. Seconded by Peters and passed with a vote of four (4), One (1) absent – Stender.
