ORDINANCE NO. 2023-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 123, REMOVING LIMITS TO THE PERMITTED NUMBER OF FIRE POLICE OFFICERS AND INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION TO THE FIRE BOARD TO \$200.00.

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Point, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

A. Section 6.A. of the Ordinance is removed in its entirety and replaced with the following:

The Fire Police shall consist of members in good standing from any member company of the Fire Department, nominated as such companies shall determine and appointed by the Board of Supervisors. The Board of Supervisors shall furnish each fire policeman a certificate of his appointment and a badge.

- B. Section 8. of the Ordinance is amended to increase the annual appropriation from the Board of Supervisors to the Fire Board from \$50.00 to \$200.00.
- C. Miscellaneous Provisions
 - 1. Severability. If any section or provision of this Ordinance is adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unlawful, void, or unenforceable, all the remaining sections and provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
 - 2. Repealer. This Ordinance shall repeal in its entirety Point Township Ordinance No. 152.
 - 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its enactment.
