#### **FESTIVAL LINEUP**

#### 1. My Desk

In a cluttered brokerage bullpen, a messy party-girl and her meticulous colleague spar over ethics, insurance, and a see-sawing tech stock as a trading day—and their friendship—hangs in the balance.

#### 2. Armed Guard

A dramatic thriller about a veteran ex-cop and a bright-eyed rookie share a tense shift guarding mob turncoat "Knuckles" Fanetti in a high-security hotel suite, where every small talk detail could mean the difference between calm routine and chaos.

#### 3. In the Weeds

Two amateur birdwatchers hunker behind roadside bushes on Long Island, determined to snap the perfect shot of a rare Lazuli Bunting while unraveling a quiet tale of deception, strange ties, and buried grievances—chip away at their teamwork.

#### 4. The Highway

A pop-up confessional booth stands quietly on a bustling city corner. It draws a clergyman who operates from a place of personal conviction more than institutional doctrine, a haunted therapist, and an anxious actor into a quick-fire exchange on faith, therapy, and modern distractions, each finding unexpected clarity before the red light flips off.

EACH ORIGINAL SHORT PLAY RUNS APPROXIMATELY 15 MINUTES, OFFERING A FAST-PACED BLEND OF HUMOR, DEPTH, AND CHARACTER-DRIVEN STORYTELLING. NO INTERMISSION.
