Lone Pine Cemetery has sat on a hillside above Bigfork since 1899, facing the Swan Range. For 127 years it has been the resting place of the people who built this community — homesteaders, veterans, business owners, neighbors, and friends. Many of Bigfork’s oldest families have ancestors here, and their descendants have kept coming back every spring to care for it.

The Lone Pine Cemetery Association has maintained these grounds entirely through volunteer effort since 1917. Our members are proud of that tradition — and they are also getting older. Some are no longer able to help the way they used to. **We need the next generation of Bigfork residents to step up and carry this forward — before there’s no one left who can.**

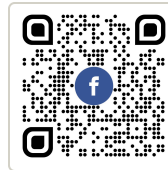
