



## Canfield 4th of July 2021

### Parade Registration Packet

Dear Parade Participant,

The Canfield 4th of July Committee cordially invites your organization to take part in our 2021 4th of July Parade, to be held on Monday, July 5th. We hope that you will join us. We are planning for a traditional parade, that will line up at the Fairgrounds and proceed along S. Broad Street and around the Green, as we have in previous years. As of April 14, 2021, we have tentative permission to hold a traditional parade, and we are planning a 'reverse' parade as a back up plan. What that basically means is that all of our parade participants would be stationary along the streets at the Fairgrounds and the people viewing the parade would drive past the entries. We are planning this reverse parade as a backup plan, depending on what the state and county officials mandate as we get closer to parade day. We believe the reverse option could work very well, and is definitely better than canceling. It would also allow 4-H groups to show off more animals than they have been able to show in the past. As with floats in previous years, we are encouraging every group participating to creatively decorate their space.

That being said, we are asking that each participant plan their float for our traditional parade, but to be prepared to change to a stationary location if necessary.

Once again, this year's participants will be eligible for cash prizes! In addition to a plaque honoring 4 levels of awards, each of the 4 designations will also be given a monetary award. Floats must be patriotic in design and correlate to this year's theme, which is "Together Again!". On parade day, between 8:45 a.m. and 9:45am, participants will be judged on a scale of one to five by a panel of three judges for originality, attractiveness and detail. **If you are no longer the primary representative of this organization, please forward this Parade Registration Packet to the correct contact person.**

Please complete and mail the enclosed Registration Form by **June 10, 2021**. After entry forms have been received, you will be contacted with further details. Please be patient, you will not be contacted until all registrants have been assigned in the line-up. If you are not participating in this year's parade but would like to stay on the mailing list please indicate that on the Registration Form. ## Canfield 4th of July 2021

### Parade Rules & Participation Guidelines

**THE 4TH OF JULY COMMITTEE HAS ESTABLISHED THESE PARADE RULES & GUIDELINES TO:**

- Assure the safety of all parade entrants and spectators
- Keep the parade moving at a steady pace
- Maintain the traditional parade atmosphere that we all enjoy and expect

**GENERAL RULES FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS:**

1. Register by June 10, 2021.
2. Distribution of items other than candy is **NOT** permitted. No flyers, coupons, etc.
3. Candy throwing from a vehicle, unit, or float is **NOT** permitted. This is a safety and ability issue. Violators will be expelled from the parade route by the Canfield Police Department. In addition, violators will be excluded from future parades.
4. To distribute candy you must have designated candy-walkers. Candy-walkers walk with the unit on the white lines at the side of the street. This is an important child safety issue. Candy-walkers must keep pace with their unit.
5. Bullhorns are **NOT** permitted. Sound systems must be pre-approved by the Committee.
6. **ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST CONTINUE TO MOVE FORWARD AND MAY NOT EXIT THEIR VEHICLES UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.** Stopping the parade progression will **NOT** be tolerated by the Parade Committee. The Committee and the Canfield Police Department will be monitoring the progression of the parade to assure that entrants are not in violation of this rule.
7. No water-propelling devices are permitted. (Examples include super-soakers, squirt guns, and water balloons.)
8. **ALL** animal entries must be followed by participant-supplied cleaning personnel.

**FOR PROFIT - BUSINESS ENTRANTS:**

1. See General Rules above.
2. Your participation must be pre-approved by the 4th of July Committee.
3. Float/unit must be decorated using a patriotic theme.
4. **No advertising brochures, flyers, or coupons may be distributed.**
5. A minimum \$50 contribution, payable to the Canfield Fourth of July Committee, **IS REQUIRED** with application. (Note: The Canfield Fourth of July Parade is a nonprofit event and relies on contributions from community residents and businesses.)

**DIGNITARIES/OFFICE HOLDERS/CANDIDATES FOR OFFICE:**

1. See General Rules above.
2. Your participation must be pre-approved by the Parade Chairperson.

**COMPLIANCE:**

These Parade Rules & Guidelines are established to enhance the safety and enjoyment of everyone involved. Thanks to participants' compliance we have had great parades for many years. To ensure compliance with the 2021 Parade Rules & Guidelines, Committee members and Canfield police officers will again be stationed along the parade route. Failure to comply with the Parade Rules & Guidelines will result in: (1) Immediate removal from the parade route, (2) Exclusion from participation in future parades. Thank you for your cooperation. We look forward to another safe, enjoyable, & fun 4th of July.
