



#### **Engagement Survey Results**


In early April, we released a survey based on the church's engagement on the ongoing Building Ministry project, communications and engagement. We had 70 responses in total! See the results in the left side box.

#### Romans 12:3-5

12 Brothers and sisters, in view of all we have just shared about God's compassion, I encourage you to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, dedicated to God and pleasing to him. This kind of worship is appropriate for you. <sup>2</sup> Don't become like the people of this world. Instead, change the way you think.
