Statement of Faith

Camp Rules and Regulations

- 1. **Attending Services:** All campers must attend all sessions of the camp program unless excused by the Pastor or Camp Director.
- 2. **Stay at Campsite:** All campers are expected to stay with their respective groups during Group Dynamics Sessions and other Group activities.
- Leaving Campsite: All campers must have permission from the Pastor or Camp Director before leaving the property or any other undesignated areas.
- 4. **Bible and Booklet:** All campers are expected to bring their Bibles and Camp Booklet during services, devotions and group dynamic sessions.
- 5. Dress Attire: All campers are expected to dress modestly.
- 6. **Camper's Participation:** All campers are encouraged to listen attentively during services and take notes for future reference/study.
- 7. **Children Care:** To ensure you and other campers can concentrate during services, we recommend that you bring your Children under 12 years of age to the Children Areas to attend their own camp activities.
- 8. **Room Assignments:** Camp Staff had worked hard to assign campers the best they can for their convenience. Stay in your designated rooms and have a fellowship with your room mates.
- 9. **Noise and Behaviour:** Observe silence and proper and decent behaviour at all times including your words, actions, voice.
- 10. **Meal Schedules:** Please proceed to the Dining/Kitchen Area during meal schedules so staff will finish their clean up at the same time.
- 11. **Lights Off:** See Camp Schedule for specific times. Please be mindful of other campers who may be resting already.
- 12. Camp Site Clean Up: All campers are expected to do their clean up at the designated time on Sunday and prior to the departure from the camp site. All common areas(i.e. Kitchen, Sanctuary, Washrooms) are to be maintained by designated campers/groups. See your Dorm Marshals for any questions and/or concerns.
- 13. **Safety Measures:** Physical Distancing and Washing of Hands are encouraged while in the camp sites. Masking is optional.
- 14. Feeling Sick or Unwell: Please approach the medics immediately.
