Meeting 26-03

The Board of Commissioners of the Manhasset Park District (MPD) convened at the Manhasset Park District Office at 62 Manhasset Avenue in Manhasset, New York at 7:30 A.M. Friday, February 27, 2026. Present were Commissioners Mark S. Sauvigne, David Paterson and Kenneth Weigand. In addition, Brian Nguyen, Manhasset resident, Robert Morici, MPD Legal Counsel, and Amanda Niewender, Secretary to the Board of Commissioner was also present.

Numerous communications addressed to the MPD pertaining to a wide array of matters were reviewed and discussed and eventually disposition was made to those, which warrant action.

Motion was made to enter into Executive Session by David Paterson, Motion seconded by Mark Sauvigne and all voted "aye" Executive Session started at 7:30 A.M. to discuss employee matters.

2. Payment and Receipts

The following resolution was proposed:

3. Brian Ngyuen

4. HS – use of lot

The Manhasset HS has submitted an application to use the lot on April 24. The Board approved and we will cone off the area for them.

5. PERMA points

Amanda notified the Board that PERMA issues rewards points for all of the safety trainings. We have accumulated a significant amount of points over the years. The points can be converted into gift cards. The Board approved to redeem them for Dunkin gift cards to be used for group trainings and as needed for meetings.

6. PERMA Conference

Amanda notified the Board that she and Ralph will attend the conference in May.

7. Digital Updates

All the staff has been trained on digital code enforcement and the digital permit system inside. In March we will publicize to the public that we are going digital. We expect to see an uptick of digital permit usage.

8. Employee Updates

Christopher was cleared by his doctor to return to work outside with certain restrictions. The supervisor will make sure they are followed.

9. Emergency Salt purchases

With the 48 inches of snow we have seen this winter, it has been difficult keeping up with the salt purchases as we do not have anywhere to store large quantities. The following was proposed:

WHEREAS, with the storms, there has been a widespread shortage of rock salt and ice melt

WHEREAS, we must purchase the salt and ice melt to keep the lots clear and avoid black ice with the cold temperatures.

WHEREAS, we have done our best to find salt and get it in time for the storm, but have had to exceed the budget,

THEN THEREFORE, it is resolved, to make purchases as necessary for rock salt and ice melt, wherever it is possible to find at the last minute, not to exceed \$10,000 total.

On a voice vote, this resolution was unanimously approved.

10. Next Month's Meetings

The meetings for March will be March 9 at 8am and March 23 at 6pm.

Having no other items on the agenda, Motion was made by David Paterson, Secretary to adjourn the meeting. Motion seconded by Mark Sauvigne and all voted "aye".
