Meeting 26-09

The Board of Commissioners of the Manhasset Park District (MPD) convened at the Manhasset Park District Office at 62 Manhasset Avenue in Manhasset, New York at 6:15 P.M. Tuesday, May 26, 2026. The Board discussed the nonresident parking and student parking. It seems to be working out and we will continue the same regulations in June. They further discussed the summer parking. They will allow nonresident to park anywhere in lot #3 in July and August only.

4. Motorcycle Spaces

We currently have 4 motorcycle spaces. They seem to be underutilized. They Board would like to make 2 of the regular commuter spaces by using a small portion of the safety zone.

5. Electrical Quote/ Sprinkler at Park Avenue

The board reviewed the quote for electric at Park Avenue. This would be to put in a new sprinkler system. At this time, the costs cumulatively for this project has surpassed the budget. The Board has decided to not continue planning for a sprinkler system. They will reevaluate and possible just put in a water connection, for our men to manually water.

6. CFM

The audit is complete. They will come in June to present their findings.

7. Updates

We now have 3 seasonal applications, which will fill all vacancies. The staff will begin working on removing the bushes at Park Avenue now that we got the all clear from 811. The garbage can at George Street was hit by a vehicle, it was repaired but may need to be replaced in the future.
