

**BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**  
**MANHASSET PARK DISTRICT**  
**REGULAR MEETING JUNE 16, 2022**

Meeting 22-10

The bi-monthly regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Manhasset Park District (MPD) convened at the Manhasset Park District Office at 62 Manhasset Avenue in Manhasset, New York at 6:15 P.M. Thursday, June 16, 2022. Present were Commissioners Mark S. Sauvigne, David Paterson and Kenneth Weigand. In addition, Andrew Schwenk, Manhasset Greater Council, George Schietinger, Manhasset Resident and Amanda Niewender, Secretary to the Board of Commissioner.

Numerous communications addressed to the MPD pertaining to a wide array of matters were reviewed and discussed and eventually disposition was made to those, which warrant action.

1. Approval of Minutes from Previous Meeting

2. Payment and Receipts

The following resolution was proposed:

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners for the Manhasset Park District approved payments as follows:

Checks numbered 10396-10417 totaling \$61,922.49 to be reviewed, approved and signed and Payroll Amounts of \$19,213.73 for Payroll 6/2/2022 and Payroll Amounts of \$25,278.70 for Payroll 6/16/2022 and all totaling \$106,414.92.

On a voice vote, this resolution was unanimously approved.

3. 61 Locust Street

The Board was updated by the Attorneys on the status of the sale of 61 Locust Street. There is ongoing discussion whether the MPD needs the TONH approval to sell the property. The attorneys will update the Board as this progresses.

4. Updates

Amanda updated the Board on several items, including the schedule/ priority of projects as per Ralphs chart, requests to cone the lot for the HS parade, and ticket books to be sought. Amanda explained the type of tickets we use are becoming increasingly difficult to find supply of and we will soon have to consider moving to a more modern approach.

5. Mr. Schwenk

Mr. Schwenk discussed a few items regarding MPD property, included a very dead twig tree. The Board decided to have the tree removed. The Board also discussed the response they got from TONH Councilwoman Lurvey denying the MPD proposed joint enforcement. The Board will FOIL tickets issued on Plandome Road January – May 2022.

6. George Schietinger

George Schietinger came to a meeting to discuss tickets he received. He explained to the Board he had a loss of a very close family friend and was unfocused and didn't realize he kept forgetting to scratch the coupons he had purchased. The Board requested his records. Mr. Schietinger currently only has an expired temp on his vehicle, and the Board feels if we completes the permit process, they can recommend to void 1 /3 tickets received. Mr. Schietinger will have 1 week to complete the process before the ticket needs to be submitted without void.
