REGULAR MEETING NOVEMBER 3, 2022

Meeting 22-19

The bi-monthly regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Manhasset Park District (MPD) convened at the Manhasset Park District Office at 62 Manhasset Avenue in Manhasset, New York at 6:00 P.M. Thursday, November 3, 2022. Present were Commissioners Mark S. Sauvigne, and Kenneth Weigand. Commissioners David Paterson called in. In addition, Chris Tsakidis and Marth Szchedek, nonresidents, Ben Romano, Manhasset Collision, Antonio Velasquez, Raindeew employee, Robert Morici, MPD Legal Counsel, and Amanda Niewender, Secretary to the Board of Commissioner were also present.

Numerous communications addressed to the MPD pertaining to a wide array of matters were reviewed and discussed and eventually disposition was made to those, which warrant action.

2. Payment and Receipts

The following resolution was proposed:

Ben Romano came to the meeting to discuss the parking spaces he leases from the MPD. They are set to expire at the end of the month, and he is looking to renew for as long as the Board will allow. The Board will discuss and have an answer before the expiration.

5. Antonio Velasquez

Mr. Velasquez came to the meeting to discuss a ticket he received. He works at Raindeew and his shift ended a little late so he did not get back to his meter in time. The Board discussed and there was an incident report filed against this employee by Code Enforcement. An altercation occurred at the time the ticket was issued. The Board had previously reviewed the information, and sent a letter to the owner of Raindeew regarding the incident. As far as the ticket, the Board does not see it was issued in error.

6. Nonresident assessment
