

Missoula Children's Theater return to Pinedale
"The Emperor's New Clothes" auditions begin November 1

The Missoula Children's Theatre of Missoula, Montana, will arrive in Pinedale on Monday, November 1, to audition students in grades K-12 for the production, "The Emperor's New Clothes". The Missoula Children's Theatre directors will select 50-60 students to rehearse during the week of November 1 – 5. The actors and students chosen will present a full production of "The Emperor's New Clothes" – an evening performance at 7:00 pm on Friday, November 5 in the Pinedale Auditorium.

Any student in the Pinedale or Bondurant school system, K-12, is eligible to audition including home-school students. There is no preparation required for the auditions, and no previous experience is needed. Missoula Children's Theatre will provide all scenery and costumes for this production.

Auditions will be held Monday, November 1, in the Pinedale Auditorium from 4:00 to 6:00pm. Students should arrive immediately when school is dismissed on Monday (if need be, elementary students may take the PAC bus to get to the audition, the bus arrives at BOCES at 3:45 – a PFAC representative will walk students from the bus to the auditorium).

Students must also have a signed parental consent form to audition. Consent forms are available at all Pinedale school offices and can also be downloaded at www.pinedalefinearts.com.

The selections for roles in the play are made entirely by the Missoula Children's Theatre actors. There is no guarantee that everyone who auditions will be cast in the play.
