Moviprep Patient Instructions - Colonoscopy

Step 1 of 4

- Purchase at pharmacy at least 1 week before your procedure:
 1) One container of Moviprep 4 sachets) 2) TwoTablets of Dulcolax (5mg)
- 1 week before procedure, advise your doctor if you are taking:

o Blood thinners (e.g. Coumadin)

o Diabetic medications

- o Anti-platelets such as Ticlid or Plavix (do NOT stop Aspirin)
- Please stop Iron supplements 5 days prior to the procedure.
- · NO nuts, multigrain, berries, grapes or seeds!

Step 2 of 4

2 DAYS BEFORE YOUR COLONOSCOPY:

- · Have a regular breakfast and lunch.
- · Clear fluids ONLY for dinner (see list of clear fluids below)
- Take 1 tablet of Dulcolax before bedtime

Step 3 of 4

1 DAY BEFORE YOUR COLONOSCOPY:

NO FOOD ALLOWED. For breakfast, lunch and dinner, drink only clear fluids (clear broth, clear jello, water, clear juice, tea, pop, Gatorade).

6 PM: 1 tablets of Dulcolax

10 PM: Mix sachet A + sachet B into **1L** of cold water (you may chill the preparation to make it more refreshing if you'd like).

Drink the entire prepared mixture within 60 min.

During the course of treatment, you must drink at least 2 cups of clear fluids (250ml each).

Step 4 of 4

6 HOURS prior to procedure TIME: Mix sachet A + sachet B into 1L of cold water.

Drink the entire prepared mixture within 60 min.

During the course of treatment, you must drink at least 2 cups of clear fluids [250ml each].

You may take regular medications with very small sips of water in the morning. Otherwise STOP drinking all fluids at least 4 hours before your procedure

Due to medications given for sedation, you cannot drive, take a bus, or walk until the following morning. Arrange for a ride home from the hospital with an adult companion. If you do not have an adult companion, the appointment may be cancelled.
