•	Administer prescribed medication daily, if applicable.	
•	Read your child's "take home" binder daily.	
•	Bring your child to school on time. School begins at 8:00 a.m.	
•	Not exceed 9 unexcused absences per semester.	
•	Provide a 30-day prior notice when/if changing insurance provider.

•	Have no outstanding balances on tuition or invoiced services.
