

Create your Own Kelp Forest:

The Garibaldi fish is a super bright orange fish that lives in the waters of the Pacific Ocean. It likes to hide in rocks and looks like it is glowing! Even though it is not very big, it is brave and protects its home. In this activity, you can make your own Garibaldi or a bunch!

Things you will Need:

- Paper to print out patterns of fish
- Scissors
- Glue, staplers or tape to put the patterns together.

Step 1

Print out both sides of the Patterns. It can be in color or in black and white.

Step 2

Match the patterns up so both sides of the fish are showing.

Step 3

Carefully cut out both patterns. Save the paper as you will use it to stuff your fish.

Step 4

Line up both patterns. Attach them together with either glue or staples. while stuffing your fish with scrape paper, cotton balls or any material. This step should be done slowly to ensure the two pieces close together. If necessary cut your fish so both sides are even.

Enjoy your fish. Hang them in your house or on a stick, play with them, or create your own Kelp Forest.
