LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS: (this includes small animals) will have a special parking pass and only these passes will be allowed to use the entrance by the river on Sprague Street. You can pick up your passes starting July 21st at the Fair Office. You can pick up project entry tags for craft and Home Ec. projects at the Fair Office at that time.

ALL MARKET EXHIBITORS exhibitors must attach their YOCA/Jr Livestock/ Education/ Equine only course certification to their fair entry. They must complete a Livestock Owners Certificate for each market species found on fairentry.com welcome page by June 30th @ midnight. This step must be completed in order to show and sell. No Fair Entry, Owner's Certificates or Animal welfare course certificates will be accepted after June 30th.

ALL NON-MARKET LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS MUST COMPLETE a <u>Non-Market Livestock Lease Contract</u>, if the exhibitor does not own the animal he/she is bringing to Fair. This form can be found on fairentry.com welcome page.

NON-LIVESTOCK YOUTH EXHIBITORS OR PARENT: Will be able to purchase a general parking pass for \$5.00. This will get you in any gate **except** the livestock gate. You can begin purchasing your passes July 21st at the Fair Office.

ADMISSION TO AMPHITHEATER: Youth Exhibitors who have projects entered in 2025 Fair will be admitted for \$2.00 every night. Exhibitors will use their weekly admission pass; which can be picked up at the fair office free to all youth exhibitors. The exhibitors admission pass is the responsibility of the exhibitor and will NOT be replaced if lost. A weekly pass will be available in advance for adult's for \$70.
