**TWO ASPECTS OF MERCY:**

2) H \_\_\_\_\_ C \_\_\_\_\_ for those who are suffering.

The FLIP SIDE to showing mercy: N \_\_\_\_\_ blessed are those  
who are N \_\_\_\_\_ merciful, for they will N \_\_\_\_\_ be shown mercy  
(Matthew 18:23-35; James 2:13).

The Promise = “for they will be shown mercy” – both NOW  
and N \_\_\_\_\_ Y \_\_\_\_\_ (see Matthew 25:31-40).

How? Abiding in Jesus, and asking God to grow us in an
