**Do you regularly practice a repentance or purity inventory?**

PURE = U \_\_\_\_\_

HEART = the C \_\_\_\_\_ of one’s being—it includes the mind, the W \_\_\_\_\_ and the E \_\_\_\_\_.

Self-examining prayers of repentance are NOT related to our S \_\_\_\_\_. Instead, this is part of our transformation P \_\_\_\_\_.

The Promise = “they will see God” (Both N \_\_\_\_\_ (see God by F \_\_\_\_\_ in the events, situations and C \_\_\_\_\_ around us) And N \_\_\_\_\_ Y \_\_\_\_\_ (one day seeing God with T \_\_\_\_\_ eyes) (Job 19:25-27)
