

**“Having Jesus’s Attitude...at a Time Like This:  
Peacemaker” -- Matthew 5:9**

“Blessed are the P \_\_\_\_\_ ....”

OR

“We need to be S \_\_\_\_\_ F \_\_\_\_\_”

God is P \_\_\_\_\_ and He also P \_\_\_\_\_ His P \_\_\_\_\_ to those who come to Him.

Jesus (the Messiah) is called “The P \_\_\_\_\_ of Peace”

Jesus passes on His peace to His D \_\_\_\_\_.

And as His followers, we have the R \_\_\_\_\_ and the C \_\_\_\_\_ to be peacemakers. (Romans 12:18; Hebrews 12:14; James 3:18).

But being a peacemaker can ONLY come through a C \_\_\_\_\_ H \_\_\_\_\_ (perhaps this is why the other beatitudes preceded this one...)

The Promise: “for they will be called C \_\_\_\_\_ of G \_\_\_\_\_”

Peace comes through right R \_\_\_\_\_.

The “NOW” and “NOT YET” of this promise are found in 1 John chapter \_\_\_\_\_

To “be like Christ” = glorified body...but also co-H \_\_\_\_\_ with Him.

- 2) Promoting R \_\_\_\_\_ within the Church.
- 3) Engaging in the attitudes and actions that Jesus
