
## "A Series of 'Firsts' –Part 2" Proverbs 1:7, 2:1-6

FOUR "So What" phrases you can use/ask:
1) So, what do I D F? (ties into last week: Seek first His Kingdom and His righteousness)
2) So what does God's Word S? (Do you understand what you are reading? What are you observing on the page?)
3) So what did this MBT? (Get yourself a study Biblethen do this, this, and this)
4) So what does this M for me, T? (Individualistic or C approach to Scripture?)
Transition from looking at the W through a W lensto looking at it through a B lens.
