

## **“Psalms that say, ‘Thank you, Lord’: Psalm 30” Psalm 30:1-12**

“Songs of Thanksgiving” Psalms —> when God E\_\_\_\_\_   
His help to you in the midst of a C\_\_\_\_\_ situation   
or when God A\_\_\_\_\_ a prayer you’ve been praying.

How often do you spend in D\_\_\_\_\_ prayer time just   
thanking God?

Psalm 30:

- Written during the M\_\_\_\_\_ period
- At the D\_\_\_\_\_ of the temple (more specifically,   
at the T\_\_\_\_\_ floor of Araunah)
- And likely used again after the Temple got C\_\_\_\_\_
- David “D\_\_\_\_\_ out” of the three day P\_\_\_\_\_

PART 1: L\_\_\_\_\_ up the Lord, because He is a God   
who L\_\_\_\_\_ up (vss. 1-3)

PART 2: God sometimes has to use C\_\_\_\_\_ and   
D\_\_\_\_\_ to get our attention (vss. 4-5)

PART 3: C\_\_\_\_\_ and R\_\_\_\_\_ should lead   
right into thankfulness (vss. 6-10)

PART 4: R\_\_\_\_\_ comes as God H\_\_\_\_\_ us and   
A\_\_\_\_\_ our prayers (mourning —>D\_\_\_\_\_);   
Sackcloth —> clothing of joy (of salvation); A new song (a   
heart/G\_\_\_\_\_ attitude)

The L\_\_\_\_\_ and F\_\_\_\_\_ phrase is what makes Psalm 30   
a “Song of Thanksgiving” Psalm!
