## Mark's Minute

Here we stand at the beginning of 2025! As you step into 2025...into this New Year... I'd like to ask you to do something that might seem a bit strange: Think about January 1, 2026. That's right. Think about that day one year from now, 52 weeks from now, 365 days from now. As you think of January 1, 2026—how will you reflect back on 2025? What will Shalom have accomplished in 2025? What will the church be doing a year from now? What new faces will have joined our Sunday School classes, our worship services, and our teams? What mission projects will we have completed? Will we meet and even exceed our budget? In what ways will we be more unified? In what ways will we be even more effective...and more efficient? Who will have joined our choir this year? Our youth group? Our children's ministry? Our nursery? And, most importantly, who will have a relationship with Jesus this time next year (who currently doesn't have one)? This is a time to grow...to set goals...to risk...to "go for it"...and to accomplish all that God wants Shalom Baptist Church to accomplish in 2025!

But this isn't just about what the church (as a whole) will do in 2025...it's also about you...and your spiritual walk. When January 1, 2026, rolls around, how will you look back on 2025 regarding your own spiritual journey? What are your personal spiritual resolutions? Will your resolution be related to your prayer life? (Regular prayer walks? Praying with your spouse more or with your children? Will you teach your grandkids the importance of prayer? Will you literally sit or kneel down in a walk-in closet/ a quiet place to pray?) Or perhaps your resolution will be related to your study of Scripture? (Will you pick a few books of the Bible to work through slowly and thoughtfully this year? Will you read a Psalm a day? Or maybe a Proverb? Will you make more of an effort to be present in your Sunday School class, step into a Grow Group or be a part of Wednesday night fellowship and Bible Study?) Will your resolution be related to your giving (Will you increase your giving this year? Will you ask God to help you learn to give cheerfully and trust Him with those gifts? Will you teach your children or grandchildren the importance of giving?) Will you seek to discover and use your spiritual gifts to serve God and others? Will your resolution be related to your worship? (Will you be more consistent in your worship participation? Will you help get the family up and ready on Sunday mornings? Will you take the lead in demonstrating to your family how important worship is to you?) As you step over into 2025, consider where you'll be a year from now...as you step into 2026!

Let's each climb at least one spiritual stair step closer to Christ this year! Let's each make some intentional choices to grow in Him! Let's each be further along in our spiritual journey a year from now. So that you and I may have a truly blessed 2025!

You may be surprised (as I am) to learn that MCEF is supported by 36 Mechanicsville churches!

The pantry is pretty well stocked as of December 9th. In the last month, the "One Stop Shop" has been able to provide food for 582 people (214 children and 368 adults). This includes 119 Thanksgiving bags of food. In total there were 254 bags plus 24 second bags given out. They also had 16 families who have signed up for food assistance.

Because of your generosity MCEF will be providing special food bags for Christmas too!

Current needs are peanut butter, pancake mix and syrup!
