Tony Evans' words seem appropriate as we stand on the brink of a brand new year. He writes,

"Before you and I were saved, we were like radios that only had one station. Everything we heard was from the vantage point of the old us. When you come to Christ, a new station has been added to your life. But unless you tune in, you will never hear the music.

Many of us are still feeding from the old station and so we are living the old way even though God has given us a brand new channel. Unless you tune in, however, you will never hear about the power that you have in Christ. That's why you don't hang around people who are only playing old music...if you do, you are going to be...singing the same old song! 


