Broken – Jesus breaking bread at last supper, Christian
fellowship (connectedness, fellowship, U)
Divided – false T attempting to divide the C
Also, division of O caused by Paul's
Also, division of O caused by Paul's preaching (people not focusing on the "main thing")
Bread – Jesus' literal B (broken).
Jesus viewed the C through the lens of brokenness.
Satan expected the cross to be a D But God, in His Sovereignty, would use the cross as a U
Humble individuals taking communion → lead to humble
churches → lead to the humble linking of churches → lead to
a movement of H across communities.
Because "bread" also represents the B of C (the Church).
P (divided) vs. H (broken)
3 things that should unify us: 1) Our H 2) C itself 3) The ground is L at the cross
One more word for "divided" – divided for the purpose of D
What Satan views as a LC, God can most definitely redeem for HC!
