Mark's Minute

I am so thankful for our Shalom Strategic Leadership Team! They have been meeting with me on a monthly basis to galvanize our new Shalom Vision and Mission Statements. You will most definitely start seeing the following information more and more around Shalom!

Our Vision is simply this: "Shalom Baptist Church...a community of believers that seeks to Gather, Glorify, Grow, and Go...in the Lord!

And our Mission Statement simply fleshes out each of those four ACTION verbs:

Gather: Hospitality is crucial to the success of any church. Visitors and members alike need to feel invited, cared for, accepted and loved. The whole church must have a mindset of inclusivity. We must greet and serve each other as Christ did—without judgment, without ulterior motive, but with sincerity and a genuine desire to see each other grow in their service and love for the Lord

Glorify: We glorify God in all aspects of our lives. Worshipping God is a lifestyle. In Psalm 42:1-4 we read that we are to long to know God with an unquenchable thirst, seeking after Him, no matter what we are going through in life. Worshipping God in this way means that we bring all of who we are into His presence and glorify Him with our actions, participation, commitment and dedication. We seek to experience God in worship by drawing together on a regular basis to celebrate Him.

Grow: We recognize that being discipled is a key to spiritual growth (Jesus had disciples/pupils). We also recognize that within the larger group, growth and discipleship generally happen within "smaller community" (i.e. small groups—the disciples were called out of the larger crowd). Discipleship and growth, thus, happen when people participate in, connect into, and engage in these smaller, more personal settings and situations. This opens up doors of being known, knowing others, and knowing God more intimately.

Go: "Go" is a very strong command from our Lord. The word "go" is used 1,542 times in God's Word. Going is an intentional transition of moving forward in one's spiritual maturity. United in faith, followers of Christ are automatically called to minister to others. As spiritually mature Christians, we were created, saved, called and commanded to "Go!"

May God bless YOU as you Gather, Glorify, Grow and Go!


