"Blessed are the P in S" have their roots in I 61:1. (A Messiah prophesy)
1) B (Makarios)—more than "H F "; rather deep C and deep S in the Lord.
2) "P" is not merely financial, it is spiritual (afflicted, oppressed, P, without H, desperate). However, Jesus brought GOOD NEWS!
Poor in S = genuinely H before God and truly D upon God.
Poor in spirit (lowercase "s") = MORE in (Holy) S (capital "S").
3) A promise phrase → "for theirs is the K of H" Humbling before Godand repentance lead into a R with God.
"In God's Kingdom, the one who G L wins." (Dr. Tony Evans)
In order for this C to experience more "poor is spirit", it better S with M learning from God how to P be "poor in spirit".
