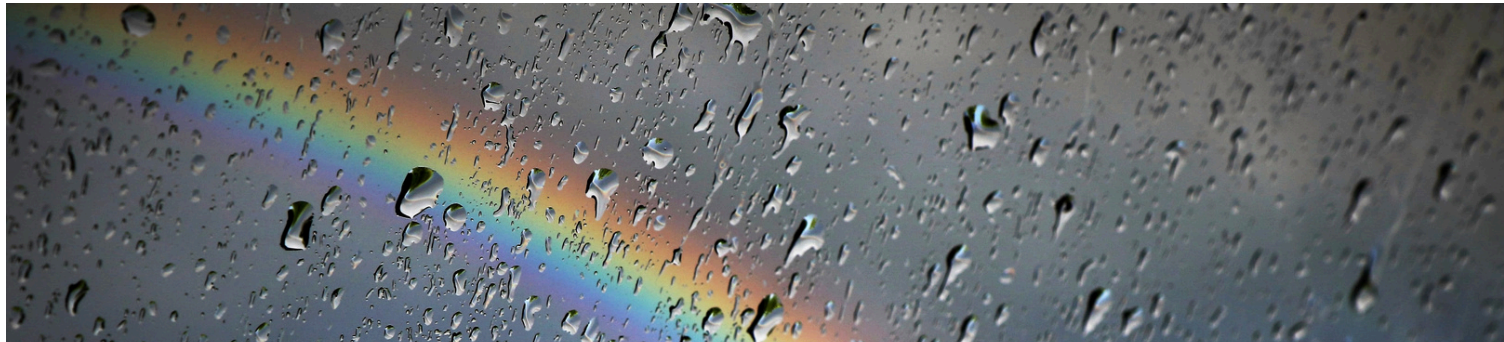

Mark's Minute

Most of us have at one time or another had to have put something together “step by step”. Maybe it was a new piece of furniture (that you purchased in a box), or a children’s gift at Christmas time (a dollhouse or a soccer goal for the backyard). We get what it means to “do something, step by step”.

As you know by now, Shalom has been in a discovering and discerning process over these last several weeks as we have been learning about spiritual gifts (Special abilities given by God through His Holy Spirit at the moment of conversion). These Biblical spiritual gifts are given to us (believers in Christ) in order to glorify God, build up the Body of Christ (the Church) and bring unity into the church. We find lists of spiritual gifts in 1 Corintihians 12:8-10, 28; Romans 12:6-8; Ephesians 4:11; 1 Peter 4:9-10; Exodus 31:3; 1 Tim. 2:1-2; and Psalm 150:3-5. But...what do these lists of spiritual gifts have to do with us...and what do they have to do with a “step by step” process? Well...let me show you:

- STEP 1: (Discovery): Pick up a spiritual gifts assessment/questionnaire at Shalom (on the welcome table, in your Sunday school class or in the Music Room).
- STEP 2: Put your name on the top of the assessment before filling it out.
- STEP 3: Take it home and fill it out (follow the directions on the assessment).
- STEP 4: Determine your spiritual gifts. Transfer the numbers from each question to the master sheet AND THEN add the columns up and put a total number at the bottom of each of those columns.
- STEP 5: What are your 3 highest “column totals”? Those are your top 3 spiritual gifts. Write those 3 gifts in the blanks provided
- STEP 6: Bring your spiritual gift (all filled out with your name on it) back to someone at the welcome center in the lobby of Shalom.
- STEP 7: Attend the “What’s Next” luncheon on March 16 at 12:15 to meet around tables with others (and a spiritual gifts coach) to help you bridge your spiritual gifts to actual ministries in our church.

KEY POINT! KEY POINT! KEY POINT! -- Don’t simply sign up for the lunch if you haven’t filled out your spiritual gift assessment. This is not just a “FREE LUNCH” –we will be using a copy of YOUR spiritual gift assessment at that lunch. Then we will return it back to you.

So...there’s the “step by step” approach to spiritual gifts...discerning, discovering, bridging to ministry...and then using!

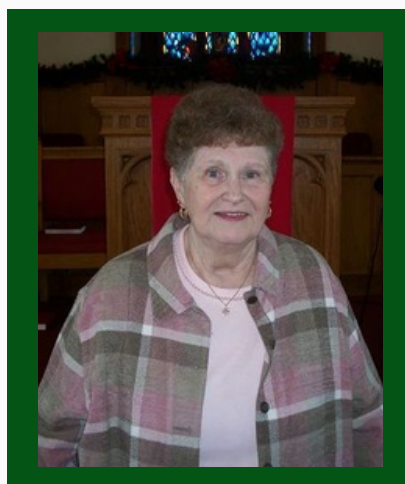

- Did you know Shalom has **TWO** AED machines. One is located on the wall next to the office door in the church lobby and the second is located in the back hallway outside of the Fellowship Hall. An AED, or Automated External Defibrillator, is a portable device that can help restart a heart that has stopped beating. AEDs are used to treat sudden cardiac arrest, a condition that occurs when the heart stops beating unexpectedly. Type this link into your browser to watch a video on how to use the AED machines. 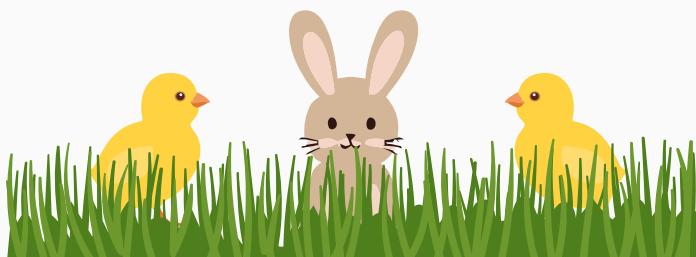

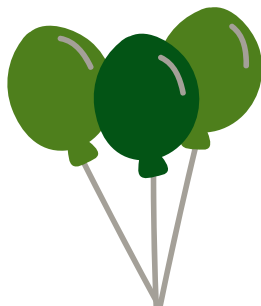
Dear Church Family,

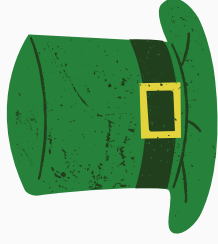
