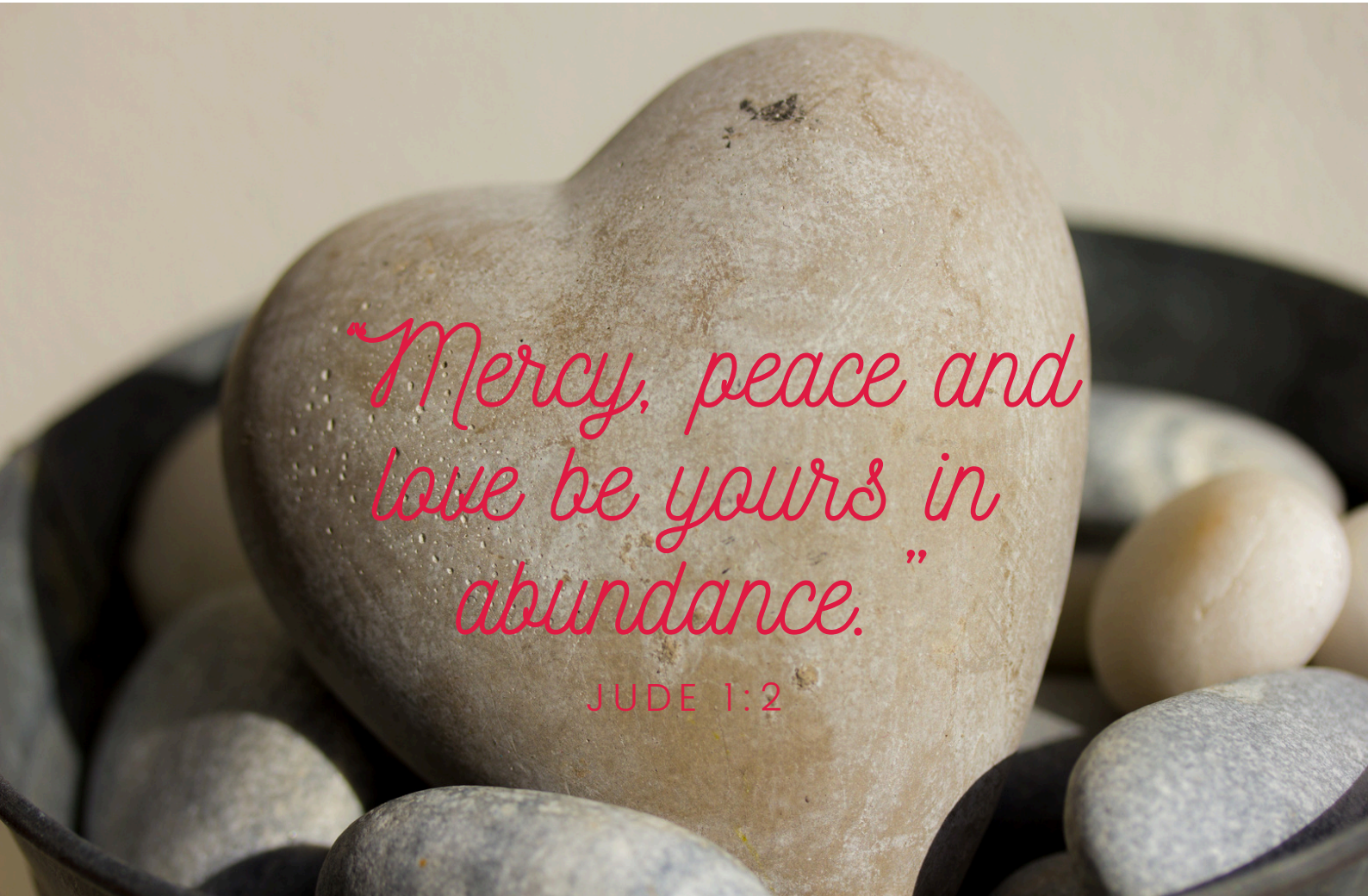

## Mark's Minute

.....  
The other morning, when I left for my morning walk, it was 11 degrees outside! A morning walk like that (for me) calls for a long-sleeved shirt, a fleece jacket, a winter coat, thick fleece pants, my Steelers knit/fleece hat, gloves and thick fleece socks. Believe me, I am all “layered up”, as I suspect many of you are during this time of year!

Colossians 3:12 reminds us to “clothe ourselves with compassion” and 1 Peter 5:5 tells us to “clothe ourselves with humility.” When people meet you for the first time, what is their first impression? Do they see your “layers” of compassion, and do they see your “layers” of humility? Compassion is a character trait that puts the needs of others above our own selfish needs and desires. Humility is the opposite of pride; it, too, is a selfless expression. These two things are in direct contrast with what our culture often clothes itself with... layers upon layers of selfishness and pride. Do people see your “Christian clothing” or your “cultural clothing” when they look at you?

What do people see when they come to our church for the first time? What is their first impression of us? Do they see “layers of compassion”? Do they see “layers of humility”? My hope and prayer is that they see a group of folks who embody Romans 13:14: “Clothe yourselves with the Lord Jesus.” When visitors walk into our lobby, are we showing them we that we are clothed with the Lord Jesus? When they walk into a new Sunday school class are we clothed with the Lord Jesus? When they walk into our Wednesday night fellowship meals, are we clothed with the Lord Jesus? When students walk into our youth ministry are we clothed with the Lord Jesus? When children come into our children’s programs are we clothed with the Lord Jesus? When people step foot in our nursery are we clothed with the Lord Jesus?

My point is this: what is their first impression? I pray that they see Jesus in who we are and in everything we do. Any business executive, any motivational speaker, any interview trainer will tell you the same thing: The first impression is critical to your success. I would take that a step further and say that the first impression that we, as a church, project could very easily be the difference between someone accepting Jesus as Savior.... OR...never stepping foot in a church again.

So, Shalom, let’s make sure that we are “layering” up all year long... with compassion, with humility...and with the Lord Jesus!

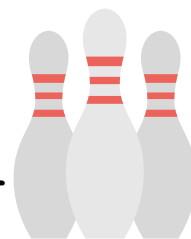

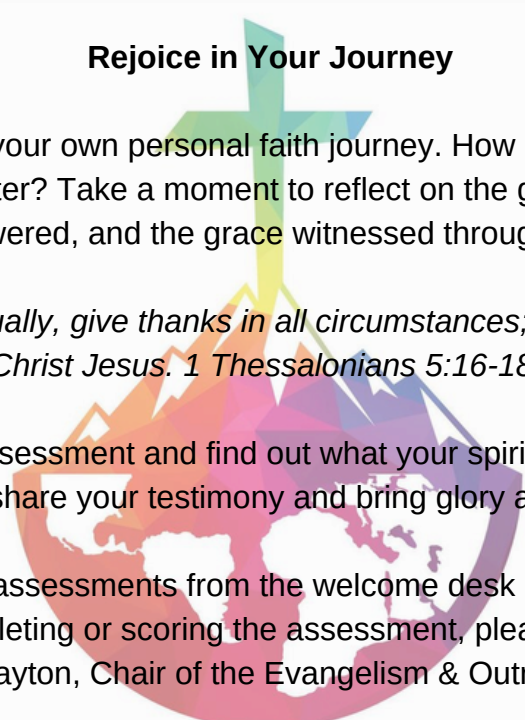
## Rejoice in Your Journey
