

**“Introducing...the Jesus-Attitudes”**  
**Matthew 4:12-17; 5:1**

- 1) Let's not just be I \_\_\_\_\_ ABOUT these “Jesus-Attitudes”; instead, let's be T \_\_\_\_\_ BY them.
  - 2) These “Jesus-Attitudes” should NOT be approached from a “S \_\_\_\_\_-H \_\_\_\_\_” standpoint...but rather, from a “G \_\_\_\_\_, H \_\_\_\_\_!” standpoint.
  - 3) These “Jesus-Attitudes” are sometimes referred to as “The B \_\_\_\_\_” (the first part of the first sermon of Jesus).
  - 4) The ONLY way to step into these “Jesus-Attitudes” is with a H \_\_\_\_\_ of R \_\_\_\_\_ (see Matthew 4:17).
  - 5) Where was Jesus when He preached about these attitudes? (in C \_\_\_\_\_).
  - 6) Each “Jesus-Attitude” is packed with M \_\_\_\_\_.  
(They are like seeds that will later blossom into major B \_\_\_\_\_ themes).
  - 7) To fully understand these “Jesus-Attitudes” we will need to get into the M \_\_\_\_\_ of a F \_\_\_\_\_ - C \_\_\_\_\_ Jewish person.
  - 8) These “Jesus-Attitudes” are centered around the Kingdom of G \_\_\_\_\_.
  - 9) The importance of “B \_\_\_\_\_” (“Makarios”, in Greek)
