I am William Comlope Johnson. My Father was Carl Gene Johnson, He was born in Pittsburg, California North East of San Francisco, to James Verdon Johnson WWII USAAC Veteran and Opal Violet Collins Robb, a "Rosie Riveter" My Father had a half-brother I met when my grandmother died. Maybe a James, he had brown eyes while my father has blue, I found and scanned a picture who I thought was my father about 12 years old, brown eyes is my uncle. My Fathers older sister Joyce still lives in San Francisco area with her family as far as I know, we haven't kept in touch. My father worked on a fishing boat in San Francisco and often goes out under the Golden Gate Bridge. He told me many stories of going out and people throwing up their lunch when the Ocean Water meets the San Francisco Bay Water causing a rough ride. Shortly after graduating High School, he was drafted into the United States Air Force as Munitions Systems Specialist (MunSystems) is an enlisted Air Force career field responsible for the safety, security, and accountability of all nonnuclear munitions and related components and after training was stationed at Takhli Royal Thai Air Force Base where he met and married my Mother, Vachara. His favorite story to tell me was about a time when he was a passenger on Military flight that was loaded incorrectly with too much weight at the front of the airplane and could not take off correctly, the pilot kept increasing speed hoping it would be able to take off, it didn't, it went off the end of the runway, broke fences, through small trees and brush rolling and kicking people out of their seats. At the very last second before crashing the plane was able to take off. Another story he told was about pilots that were competing with each other to hit a target with the least amount of bullets, they would fly in close to target, barely touch the gun trigger to let out just a few bullets and then reach under the seat to pull the electrical fuse that shut off power to the gun. It was my Father's responsibility to put that fuse back into place. Each time it takes up to an hour to remove the seat, crawl between wiring and put a new fuse back into place. The fuse is about the size of a quarter and easily lost and Pilots don't respect crews enough to keep the fuse. New one needs to be found every time. My Mother has about six brothers and six sisters. Some are actually cousins and half-siblings. Counts are difficult. Her Father was also a strong Thai military man with enough money to raise many kids and have a decent sized house for all of them in Takhli. I was born on February 12, 1972 at Takhli hospital and shortly afterward my father requested separation from the Air Force and put my Mother on a plane to Salt Lake City with all the money he had... she immediately gave all that money to her father and got on a plane to America without a cent in her pocket, but still miraculously was able to find my Grandmother. When my father was discharged and arrived in America, we got a mobile home on Redwood Road and my Grandmother lived very close on Crystal Ave on a small horse property where she had a small vegetable and chicken farm and had many sewing machines to make purses and a large delicious Plum Tree, tasted so good and the extra poop was worth it. Her Best Friend was a woman named Eve and just down the street was a man named Doug and his son Dougey or Doug Jr. they had a small horse farm and Butchered deer during hunting season business. Ms. Gellert and her daughter and their little dog Tucus or Tookie were also good friends of my grandmother and would often visit. My sister was born October 24 1976. When she was about 2-3 we were shoveling snow in front of the trailer, and she was following me too close and I accidentally hit her in the face with a metal snow shovel. She has a small scar on her upper lip to this day. My deepest regret and a reminder as to why I never hit a Woman. Grandma died when I was 16 and my Aunt and Uncle didn't get a big payout because my Grandmother lived in perpetual debt, lived on government assistance and my father kept paying all her bills. My Aunt and Uncle have not been in contact since. My earliest

memory was returning to Thailand as a toddler and seeing my mom's father's tub and I remember it to this day as being 10 feet tall and all my cousins speaking fluent Thai. When I returned to America a few months later, I only spoke Thai for a few months. My father was so mad at my Mom for this, but ever since, we had a secret language we could keep things from my Father. So much fun talking shit to his face and he never knew. When we visited Thailand again in 2000 I found my Mothers dad's bathtub. It's a regular size bathtub. Also a trip to Custer South Dakota Flintstones Land about 1975 before my sister was born, and Universal Studios Battle Star Galactica Attraction around 1980. My mother worked for Abbott Labs with many of her friends from Thailand from the mid-1980's until her retirement. Father worked Air conditioning for CCI Mechanical from 1973 until his retirement. Union Man all the way all day. Just like I am today with IATSE Local B-192 in Burbank, CA from November 2005 'til the day I die. My Mother showed signs of Alzheimer's or dementia around 2014, when my parents visited with me in Hollywood and we all went to Disneyland, Knotts, Universal and Six Flags. Her condition was already deteriorating and father had to stay close to her. My father spent every waking moment caring for her but it just became too much and he began to break down too. As a result of both their deteriorating conditions, in October of 2023, I made the decision to take my Mother out of my childhood home, away from my father knowing full well he is a gun owner and always was. I removed my mother to place her with my Sister and father called Police. Police arrived a few minutes later and agreed with us to let her go. My father started a lawsuit, he had been falling frequently due to knee or leg failure and hitting his head on concrete. A few months later, he fell and cracked his skull in the garage while setting up a mini refrigerator for the Meals on Wheels group to be able to deliver food if he was out of the house. His last fall causing brain bleed and death. My Mother lived for another 2 years and seemed happy with kids and grandkids around. I would die for my Mother and Family and regret nothing of what I did.

OK pan the camera back to me and fade up. I went to Taylorsville Elementary, Eisenhower Middle and Taylorsville High School. When I was about 3-4 grade one of the Hispanic kids thought he was a badass and kept challenging me to fight.. it went on for 3-4 days, large crowds egging us on, teachers fully heard it and witnessed it. Finally got sick of it, we went off the property and with a very large crowd of his friends and mine. I kicked him as absolutely hard as I could, right in the penis and balls. He fell to the ground and rolled around for at least 10 minutes. Tons of witnesses from teachers and students. I walked away scott-free and nobody ever challenged me to fight again. Elementary was meh, Middle School Choir was fun around Christmas singing all the songs, same High School. Then y'know GIRLS. BARELY graduated by the skin of my teeth. Still got the Diploma and enlisted in the Navy. Boot Camp in Orlando, C036 company still the best, President George H.W. Bush took office a year before.

I still remember the US 11 Navy General Orders of a Sentry.. It's been 36 Years. It's still clearly burned into my brain.

To take charge of this post and all government property in view.

To walk my post in a military manner, keeping always on the alert, and observing everything that takes place within sight or hearing.

To report all violations of orders I am instructed to enforce.

To repeat all calls from posts more distant from the guardhouse than my own.

To quit my post only when properly relieved.

To receive, obey, and pass on to the sentry who relieves me all orders from the Commanding Officer, Command Duty Officer, Officer of the Deck, and Officers and Petty Officers of the Watch only.

To talk to no one except in the line of duty.

To give the alarm in case of fire or disorder.

To call the Officer of the Deck in any case not covered by instructions.

To salute all officers and all colors and standards not cased.

To be especially watchful at night, and during the time for challenging, to challenge all persons on or near my post and to allow no one to pass without proper authority.

Salute all officers and the American Flag. Folding uniforms to fit in sea bags and all the push-ups, I remember every single one. After boot camp I reported to NTTC Correy Station in Pensacola Florida for Tactical Electronic Warfare. The Tactical Electronic Warfare Division (TEWD) at the Naval Research Laboratory develops EW systems for detecting, tracking, and countering missile threats. This includes:

Electronic Warfare Support Measures (ESM) to detect and identify incoming missiles.

Electronic Countermeasures (ECM) to jam or spoof missile guidance systems.

Counter-countermeasures to neutralize enemy EW tactics

Then I was assigned to USS Reasoner FF-1063 in San Diego, CA. Diesel powered burns a lot of gas and short range trips around Catalina was the norm. Pearl Harbor was very nice. Greatest achievement was driving the ship completely through the Panama Canal. Hands on the steering wheel for 24 straight hours, lake in the middle with tons of 10 foot diameter Jelly Fish. One of the Officers, who was an asshole before all this didn't believe me that all the white 10 foot circles in the water were Jelly. I pulled a quarter out of my pocket and dropped it into the middle of one of the circles. The look on his stupid face when that quarter seemed to hang in mid-air will be the greatest memory of my Navy time. It took everything I had not to laugh in his face and get in trouble. Totally dumb luck that I had a quarter in my pocket. Not supposed to, Officers don't like to hear your change jingle when you march... oops asshole. Drove complete through to the Atlantic, then back. Cruise ship in the Canal Lock next door to mine had busty blonde European women topless sunbathing.. mmm good times.

Perth Western Australia – Good Topless Bars and every dude is a Hemsworth. Good Genes. Good Day Mate.

August 28, 1993 Decommissioning USS Reasoner and handoff to Turkish Navy.. so much scrubbing and making sure they didn't eat any Pork.. it's like a mortal sin to eat a Hot Dog, LITERALLY.

Immediate reassignment to USS Peleliu LHA-5. Literally on the same pier, 200 feet away. Promotion and a raise to Postal Clerk Petty Officer Third Class E-4. Mailman. No regrets. Got a raise and more respect and everybody loves to see the mailman coming with a package for you. Mombasa Kenya, Mogadishu Somalia, Crossed Earth Equator between here and Australia became a 'Shell Back' for crossing the line.

National Defense Service Medal, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, Sea Service Deployment Ribbon, Joint Meritorious Unit Award, Battle "E" Ribbon, Good Conduct Award (First) Honorable Discharge – all military benefits and College Tuition good to go.

Returned to Salt Lake January 1995, computers were VERY new. Worked at Computer City/Tandy/Radioshack/IncredibleUniverse... all owned by same company. Worked there for a few months. Across from Fashion Place Mall in Murray. Then Packard Bell opened Tech Support Call Center in Magna, UT a western suburb of Salt Lake .. Company failed in July 1999 Layoffs and removal of my best friends and favorite managers. I quit because I had another job setup with Marriott Call Center Redwood and 21st South. Didn't last long there Mormon Nicey Nicey No good for me. Went to Greyhound Downtown Worked there about four years. Got the itch to get out of the cold, told Dad I was moving to LA.

October 2005 got a job at Universal Studios, saw Jay Leno almost every day doing segments for Tonight Show, Reese Witherspoon, Gabrielle Reese, Peter Falk from Columbo, Conan Obrien when they gave him the Tonight Show on the Universal Lot, but gave it back to Leno three months later. Terry Crews from Everybody Hates Chris now AGT, lots of sports people I didn't know I helped until my coworker told me who they were. Union IATSE Local B-192 covers most Universal Studios employees.. Paying my union dues 'til the day I die.
