Beginning in January, we will be housing five residents who have a desire to give back in facilitating classes and outreaches, while learning important life skills and responsibilities in an Oxford House-like setting. Upon leaving after completing their second year, they will receive back their last month's program fees, plus the initial sobriety deposit, along with a 2 year history for making payments for housing! But most important will be the skills and responsibilities learned in managing their lives and finances along with crucial leadership traits and independence. ### Kingdom Harvest Fall Festival 🗖





We would like to thank and feature Light a Candle Ministries for graciously donating LOVETOTES to our residents. Light a Candle Ministries is a ministry birthed through one of our mentors, Michelle Fay. Michelle, along with about 10 other women who regularly attend "Pack-N-Pray Parties", put together totes filled with donated items that are useful, meaningful, and inspiring, with the purpose of spreading the love of God. They call these "LOVETOTES". When the idea of LOVETOTES was formulated, Michelle brought the idea to Nannette Ward, Co-Chair of the Human Trafficking Coalition, with the intention of sharing the totes with survivors of sex-trafficking. This idea has since expanded to survivors of basically any trauma at all including homelessness, substance abuse, domestic violence survivors and more. "It's God's entrepreneurship-I'm just on board with it." Michelle said. She is extremely thankful for the support from her church congregation at Christian Fellowship of Jefferson City. The volunteers focus on targeted prayer over each LOVETOTE, community awareness, and volunteer education. We are so grateful to be able to pass these blessings on to our residents, and they truly do fill the recipients with joy!
