Trophies of God's Grace



Family and friends celebrated the commencements of Jessica Garner, Lisa Anderson, Nicole Heather and Rebecca Schuessler from The Healing House and New Beginnings program on October 10, 2020 at House of Prayer Family Church. In her opening remarks, Executive Director, Heather Gieck, referred to Ephesians 4:17-25 as direction for those commencing to “no longer walk as the rest”, “to put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man”, “be renewed in the spirit of your mind”, and “put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.” Testimonies of their transformational journeys inspired those in attendance.

Several of those close to the honorees spoke of the changes and growth they have witnessed. Included in her comments about each of the women, Pastor Dorene Jackson commented on how quiet Jess was at one time. Over time, Jess became a member of the House of Prayer worship team and of the changes in her she said, “Not only can she talk, not only can she smile, she cracks

these little jokes on me. Not only that, but she’s also a great helper.” Lisa’s daughter shared about her mother, “Little by little I’ve seen this woman transformed into the woman and the mother I always knew she could be.” Nicki’s father spoke, “I’m just glad her grandmother got to see one of her grandkids change. Your children are very proud of you. I never thought I’d see the day. I want you to know I’m proud of you.” Becky’s mother said: “I knew she could be the momma that she needed to be for her kids...I’m just really proud of you.”

Each of the women commencing the program shared some of her journey with the group. Jess shared: “All the things that seemed so important have drifted away because I’ve learned what’s truly important and that is a relationship with Jesus Christ.”

Lisa spoke of 45 years’ worth of bad decisions and turning 60 in prison. “God is the only thing and only way for me out.” She shared of truths from God that have been pivotal for her concluding, “I am forgiven. I can walk with my head up. I have a beautiful family and a chance at what’s good and decent.”

Nicki told of those who kept reaching out and praying for her

after she initially had to leave the program, thanking them for not giving up on her. Admitting she had come to the end of herself, she returned, started over at The Healing House and completed the program. Nicki stated, “I’m grateful God put it in your heart to help me.”

Becky shared that she struggled with substance use since she was 12 or 13 years old. She told of meeting Heather Gieck through her ministry in county jail and her eventual path to The Healing House. She stated that her recovery process is “one root at a time, plucking and plucking and weeding... I’m just grateful to everybody and it’s a really good place and it’s my home now.”

Heather Gieck closed the meeting releasing this word over those commencing the program. “You are God’s poetry. You are a recreated people that will fulfill the destiny He has given each of you to do. For you are joined to Jesus the Anointed One. Even before you were born God planned in advance your destiny and the good works that you would do to fulfill it. And so I release you into your destiny today in the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth. Amen.”
