Beginning March I, The Healing House and New Beginnings began partnering with House of Prayer Family Church to offer Friday night **Celebrate Recovery** meetings. Celebrate Recovery is a Christ-centered, 12 step recovery program for anyone struggling with hurt, pain or addiction of any kind. Celebrate Recovery is a safe place to find community and freedom from the issues that are controlling our lives. Originally started in 1991 at California's Saddleback Church, according to the website www.celebraterecovery.com there are now 35,000 churches offering Celebrate Recovery around the world and it's growing in other places including state prices.

Each evening starts with a meal at 6:00 followed by a time of praise and worship. Next, either a personal testimony or teaching is given, then participants meet in small groups for sharing. Healing House program residents are participating and developing leadership abilities as each week they share in the responsibility to provide the meal and meeting. **Come as you are and join us!**

Healing House and New Beginnings leaders go to Fulton one evening a week to teach a recurring 5-week Program of Action 12-Step recovery class at the Fulton Department of Corrections Community Supervision Center. Missouri's first all-female 120-day residential probation and parole program opened in February 2019 and is designed to help women prepare for life after incarceration. The Center houses up to 40 women. A group from The Healing House attended the first graduation ceremony for the women enrolled in the program.
