On May 18th, 2015 we opened the door to house our first 7 women in our first house. That was 9 years ago. In 2017 we opened our 2nd house, in 2019 our 3rd house, and at the beginning of 2024 we opened up our 4th house and now we serve 30 women with 6 children living within our community and many more mommas being reconciled with their children through the love of Christ. And the Lord said to me, "I have given you a "House" to steward, 'The Healing House and New Beginnings" It is through your partnership that we have been

able to fulfil the mandate that God has given us—rebuilding shattered lives. We could not do it without you co-laboring with us. Thank you for your partnership as we continue to build the Kingdom.




2022/2023 Ministry in Review




PROGRAM PARTICIPATION:

- In 2022, 31 women entered The Healing House and New Beginnings and there were 7 commencements.
- In 2023, 20 new residents entered the program and there were 8 commencements.

From those women, THHNB hired one new employee and 15 of those women are still with THHNB as either a first or second year resident.

PROGRAM GROWTH:

Some of the program growth during 2022 and 2023 include:

- Hired Kelli Crawford, an Alumni of THHNB, as full-Administrative Program Assistant and Mentorship Coordinator. Kelli does billing and Case Management Reviews as well as coordinates the Mentorship Program and activities.
- Hired Crystal Duwe, 3rd Year Resident/Senior Leader as full-time Assistant Program Coordinator. Crystal oversees the application and intake process as well as being trained in Case Management Reviews with the residents.
- Purchased 'Karen's House', our Next Step residence for women who are in or entering into their second year of residency in the program.
- Partnered with Transformational Housing as a referral source to which we have 2 residents currently residing as part of our Single Mother's Program.
