# DVMA Member's Mustangs

This month's featured Mustang belongs to new DVMA member Victor Harris of Antioch. Victor bought his 1967 fastback in 1990 for \$600. However, it didn't look anything like it does now. It had been used as a parts car by the previous owner and had three different sizes of tires, but it ran, and Victor drove it home from San Leandro to Emeryville. Originally a six cylinder car, it had a 289 V8 with '68 302 heads, 4 barrel carb, Edelbrock intake and headers on it when he got it. It also had a worn-out T-10 transmission, which Victor swapped out for a toploader 4 speed, doing all the work in the street!



Victor's son drove it for a while in high school, but once he went off to college, it was time for a restoration.



Victor took the car apart and down to bare metal, then got it painted in LeMans Blue with Wimbledon White stripes and got all new chrome. Inside, he added air conditioning, a Momo steering wheel, Procar seats, a hump-hugger console, white-faced gauges, and racing seatbelts. Other upgrades are four wheel disc brakes, limited-slip gears in a Lincoln Versailles rear end, 15" wheels with 275 tires out back and 235 up front, new springs, shocks, and suspension parts, a chrome export brace, MSD distributor, and an aluminum radiator. Amazingly, Victor has never had to rebuild the engine - it runs just as strong as it did when he bought it the car 32 years ago!

This upgraded classic Mustang is no garage queen, as Victor and his wife Karen have taken it on several trips down to Los Angeles, and up to Hot August Nights in Reno. During his first Reno trip, he was driving along and heard a scraping noise. He pulled into a bank drive-through, jacked up the car, found a loose brake spring, fixed it, and was on his way. On the way home, while Karen was sleeping, a driver in a 5.0 Mustang pulled alongside and made it obvious that he wanted to challenge Victor to a little speed contest. He woke Karen up and said, "This guy wants to race us." Her reply: "Go for it!" Permission granted, he proceeded to show the fox body Mustang what a '67 fastback's taillights look like. If you would like to check out this beauty in person, come on out and see it at the DVMA Car Show in Brentwood on June 5th.
