Saturday March 25 was a beautiful day for the Classic Sports Racing Group's David Love Memorial races at Sonoma Raceway. There were lots of beautiful vintage racecars on display in the paddock and tearing up the tarmac on the track. Walking through the paddock and talking with the drivers is a highlight of this event. Everyone is so welcoming and willing to chat about cars and racing. There were two beautiful Mustangs racing in Group 8, a 1965 Shelby GT 350 and a 1969 Boss 302. The '69 Boss was actually the owner's high school car, which he sold to a classmate. At his 20 year high school reunion, the classmate offered to sell the car back to him and the rest is history. David Love was well known for racing his 1958 Ferrari 250 Testarossa, and that car was on display in the garages. There were some other interesting Fords there that day, including a beautiful Saleen Fox body Mustang and two British Ford Cortinas.

An exciting race of the day was the Group 3 qualifying race at 2:00 pm. My friend Rob Fuller had qualified with the fastest lap time in his Datsun 510 and secured the pole position. He decided that that wouldn't be any fun, so he started at the very back, in 16th position, and worked his way past the other cars until he was in the number two spot going into the final lap. That last lap was a real battle as he trailed the Alfa Romeo that had led the entire race by 2 seconds, but was running a 2.1 seconds faster lap time. He pushed past the Alfa in the last turn and went on to take the win. The excitement in the crowd and in the announcers' voices was a real thrill.

## **DVMA Member's Mustangs**

When I was in high school in the 80's, I was a car crazy teenager who especially loved Mustangs. My first car, however, was a hand-me-down 1964 Plymouth Valiant coupe with a 225 slant six engine and a pushbutton automatic trans. Driving Grandpa's old car wasn't very cool, but it got me to school and work, and I saved my pennies while scouring the Auto Trader magazine for a cooler car. Through a family connection, I found a '67 Lime Gold coupe with a 289 and bought it for \$2000 in





1983. Being a teenager, of course I took a bone stock, one-owner car and put headers, mag wheels, a rear shackle kit, and other modifications on it. I had many adventures in that car and drove it for 7 years before I finally sold it.

I 2002 I finally bought another Mustang - this one a '67 Lime Gold convertible with a 289 and a deluxe black interior. This car I kept totally stock, but since

I didn't have a decent garage in which to work on it, I ended up selling it a few years later. I regretted it almost immediately, but didn't buy another Mustang until 2007.

A friend at work casually mentioned that his neighbor had a '67 coupe just sitting in his driveway and asked if I wanted to check it out. I went to look at it and it was a 390, 4 speed coupe in Acapulco Blue. A deal was made, I put a battery in it, and I drove it home. After driving it as-is for seven years, I disassembled it in 2014 and started a restoration. The cracked 390 was replaced with a fully built 428, bored and stroked to 450 cubic inches. A 5 speed transmission and 3.89 rear end were added and work was begun on the



interior. It isn't finished yet, but one of these days it will make its debut at a DVMA event. Until then, I will keep chipping away at the hundreds of little jobs that make up a restoration...
