





I just got back from judging at the MCA “Mustangs Take Flight” car show in Houston, TX. What a great venue and show! The Lone Star Flight Museum was the venue, right near the Ellington air field which is a repurposed military base. The Johnson Space Center is about 7 miles south of the museum. The museum housed some of the most excellent examples of restored aircraft that I’ve ever seen and a beautiful B-17 was taken out of the hangar and gave rides to some lucky show participants. Every registered Mustang got it’s picture taken with not one but *two* P-51 Mustangs! What a cool memento! The Mustangs “with wings” have a permanent home in the museum. Several Mustangs were displayed under the wings of some fabulous planes. Ron Freitas was also there as a judge and he scored a Boss 351 and a Mach I Cobra Jet. Both cars were older restorations and we spent a lot of time documenting the items that needed repair. As Ron and I were checking out the show field I stopped in my tracks when I spied an early dream car of mine: a 1971

Boss 351, black with silver stripes and black interior. I was instantly transported back to the year 1971 when I first beheld a car just like this one. I had been married for less than a year, I was still in the Marines on a corporal’s salary and I’d wandered into the Ford dealership to order some parts for our Ford Maverick. There it was on the showroom floor and I couldn’t help myself; I just had to slip on into the driver’s seat. Of course, the salesman came over and wanted to sell it to me. Only one problem: the \$4600 that I’d have to come up with. I always hoped to see another one and haven’t until this car show. And the guy who owned this one has taken beautiful care of it. It was a perfect restoration.. All in all this was a great show and one of the coolest venues I’ve seen.
