If it looks like a Mustang and sounds like a Mustang...

The Mustang has gone electric. Or has it? There is no dispute this is an electric car. What has the forums buzzing is whether or not this is a Mustang. Let's start by looking at the facts:

- The 2021 Mustang Mach-E is built by Ford.
- The overall shape and taillights are Mustang.
- The iconic horse is on the front grille.
- There's an abundance of horse-shaped badges.
- There's a "propulsion noise." But it's fake.
- The speedometer reads "ground speed."
- It is a true performance car.

It's that last fact that has reviewers changing their mind about the Mach-E. The general consensus is the car "feels like a Mustang." It's fast, fun, delivers superb electric range (300 miles per charge), and solves a problem many have - current electric cars are just boring. This car will definitely turn some heads. The steering wheel is substantively thick-rimmed, and the front windshield has a sports car-like view of the road but without the visual limitations of a Camaro. This is a wide, heavy, solid car that takes command of the road. It's a muscle car, and isn't that a word used to describe a Mustang? I'm pretty sure "muscle" is in the title of every one of my boyfriend's magazines.



The bottom line is Ford's got your back. The price range lands around \$40,000 but, as usual, increases when options are added. But if you're not a fan of the look or the performance or the options available there are alternatives...



Meet the **R67 prototype**, produced by Russian company Aviar Motors. They call it the "first electric muscle car." The body style looks very similar to a first-generation Mustang (can you say lawsuit) but with the insides of a Tesla Model S.


