Castro Valley held their annual car show on Saturday, June 15th, and it was pretty amazing. DVMA Board Member Mark Vasgerdsian and I met up in Lafayette at 7:45am and rolled out to Castro Valley together. Fun fact: the parking lot where we met used to be the Don Young Ford dealership, which is where Mark's car was originally sold. Both of our cars are slow lane cruisers, and he set the pace in his Metallic Ivy Glow '73 convertible while I followed in my newly acquired Wimbledon White '67 coupe.



We arrived at the staging area in the huge parking lot of Three Crosses Church, and it was "the car show before the car show" with hundreds of classic, muscle, and pony cars everywhere you looked. The cafe was open for coffee and snacks, and we picked up our registration packets and parked in color-coded zones to make staging more organized. After a while we all cruised over to Castro Valley Blvd, which was completely closed to regular traffic to make room for the hundreds of show cars, vendors, beer and wine booths, and live music stages that made up the show, not to mention the thousands of spectators strolling by.

Once all the cars were parked, the show kicked in to high gear, with so much to see on the main boulevard, plus all the surrounding coffee shops, restaurants, and stores open for eating and browsing. There were quite a lot of fine Fords and magnificent Mustangs in attendance that day, and I gave out all the flyers I brought for DVMA's October car show. There was even a Sunbeam Tiger there - the lesser known brother of the Shelby Cobra, but still following Ol' Shel's recipe of a small British roadster stuffed with Ford V8 power.



DVMA Member's Mustangs

In April of 1966, Tony Eistetter's father bought a one year old used car, a 1965 Mustang with the base six cylinder engine and an automatic transmission, for \$2150. The original owner was the father of the 1966 Rose Queen, and to celebrate that history, the car wears a license frame that says, "Pasadena Tournament of Roses".

Tony inherited this Mustang in 1989 upon the passing of his father, and as of now this pony has covered about 340,000 miles! The car underwent a major mechanical restoration in 2023, including installing a rebuilt engine, rebuilding the carburetor and transmission, plus new fuel tank & pump, suspension and tires, wiring, radiator, distributor and windshield. While the engine was out, the engine bay was repainted black. The exterior is an older repaint in original Springtime Yellow and the black interior is almost all original.

Tony enjoys adding more miles to the odometer, taking his Mustang to shows and other events where he can share this piece of family and Ford history with others.
